An original design of traditional sampler quilt squares surrounded by a stunning framed border designed with "Chelsea Lane" fabric by P & B Textiles.

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









Finished Quilt to Measure 48" x 61"

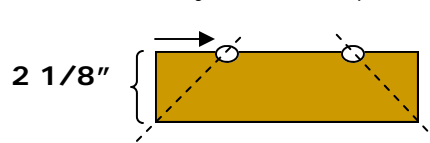
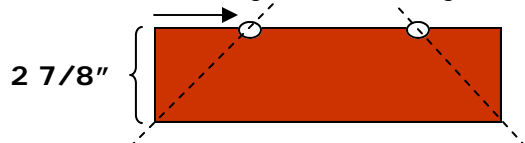
Finished Blocks to Measure 14" x 14"



Cutting Instructions for Block 6

| Fabric A | Fabric B | Fabric C | Fabric D | Fabric E | Fabric F |
|---|---|--|---|---|--|
|  |  |  |  |  |  |
| Cut ONE (1) 5 1/2" square | Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares. ----- Cut ONE (1) 5 7/8" square then cut this square diagonally TWO times.  | Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares ----- Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares then cut this square diagonally ONE time.  | Cut FOUR (4) 2 7/8" x 10 1/2" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below) | Cut FIVE (5) 3 1/8" squares then cut THREE (3) these squares diagonally ONE time.  ----- Cut TWO (2) 2 7/8" x 5 1/8" strips | Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/8" x 7 3/4" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below) |

Measure over the SIDE size from edge and draw a diagonal line from the bottom corner to your mark. Repeat on opposite side



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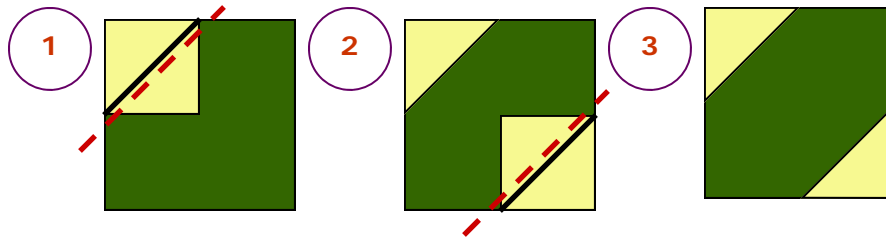
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Sewing Instructions for Block 6

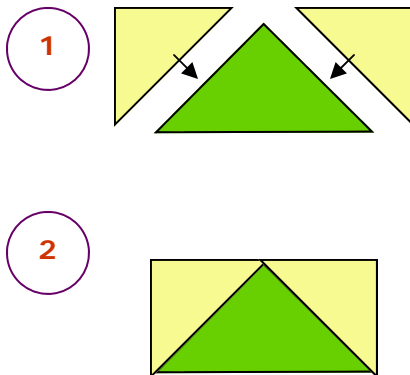
- 1) Take your 2 Fabric E squares and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner, on the back side of each. Line up one of your Fabric E squares on one of the corners of the Fabric A square and sew 1/4" to the INSIDE of the line you drew, as shown. Cut the fabric ON the line you drew. Repeat with your remaining Fabric E square. Do not discard the triangles you cut as you will use them in #3 below. Press your seams out.



- 2) Sew your four corner four-patch blocks from Fabrics B & C as shown. Repeat three more times for a total of FOUR (4) four-patch corners:



- 3) Using one of your Fabric B triangles, sew the Fabric E triangles to the sides, as shown. Press in opposite directions. Repeat three more times for a total of FOUR (4) of these pieces:



- 4) Assemble your block center, as shown:



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Sewing Instructions for Block 6 (continued)

5) Now, assemble the rest of your block:

A -- sew 2 Fabric E strips to the left and right of your center half-square triangle square.

B -- sew your 4 four-square blocks to the ends of 2 of your Fabric E strips.

C -- sew the four-square strips made in B above to the top and bottom of your center half-square triangle rectangle.

D -- sew the 4 Fabric D strips to this center block.

E -- sew the Fabric F strips to the long edge of your Fabric C triangles.

F -- sew the center block to the corner triangles you made in E above!

Finished block will measure 14 5/8" square.
