



Mosaic No. 18

Fabric requirements for this block:

Light Fabric: 1/8 yard (need a piece about 4 1/2" x 23")

Medium Fabric: 1/8 yard (need a piece about 4 1/2" x 10")

Dark Fabric: 1/4 yard (need a piece about 9" x 20"-you might be able to get this block out of 1/8 yard rather than a quarter)

Cutting for this block:

Light Fabric: Cut six 3 7/8" squares. Cut in half diagonally once to yield 12 Triangles

Medium Fabric: Cut two 3 7/8" squares. Cut in half diagonally once to yield 4 Triangles.

Dark Fabric: Cut eight 3 7/8" squares. Cut in half diagonally once to yield 16 Triangles

Assembly:

1. Sew the 12 light triangles to 12 dark triangles. Press seams toward the dark fabric.
2. Sew the 4 medium triangles to 4 dark triangles. Press seams toward the dark fabric.
3. Make sure that each half square triangle measures 3 1/2". Carefully trim to that size. Or recheck your seam allowances if the blocks do not measure 3 1/2" each and resew.
4. Lay out the rows of the block according to the layout in the block photo.
5. Sew each row and then sew rows together. Your sewn block should measure 12 1/2".
