December 2008 Instructions

Completed Quilt Size: 60" square

Block Size: 9 1/2" finished, 10" unfinished

1/4" seam allowance

Fabric Yardage - from AbbiMays.com "Royal Holiday" by Deb Strain from Moda





Putting Your Quilt Top Together

Cut the remaining FOUR (4) panel fabric blocks so that they are 10" square. Please note that you will have to cut off some of the border of the blocks.

Next, put your quilt together, as shown below. Press each row in the opposite direction, so that everything will fit together when you sew the rows together.

Your quilt top should now measure 48" square unfinished. The first border fabric should be ready (you will need to piece these together to get the correct lengths) as follows:

- TWO (2) strips 1 1/2" x 48"
- TWO (2) strips 1 1/2" x 50 1/2"

Sew these border strips to your quilt top, first the left and right sides with the shorter strips and then the top and bottom with the longer strips.

Your quilt top should now be 50 1/2" square.

Then it's time to cut and piece the final border strips, from the blue fabric (you will need to piece these together to get the correct lengths), as follows:

- TWO (2) strips 5" x 50 1/2"
- TWO (2) strips 5" x 60"

Sew these border strips to your quilt top, first the left and right sides with the shorter strips and then the top and bottom with the longer strips.

Finally, you are ready to cut and piece your binding (piecing it together so that you have enough to go all the way around your quilt top), with strips starting at 2 1/2" x WOF. Then, create your quilt sandwich, quilt the quilt and add and secure your binding.
