

Fabric	Cut
Green	Cut ONE (1) 3" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner TWO (2) times. You will need TWO of the finished triangles for this block.
Green	Cut ONE (1) 2 5/8" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner ONE (1) time. You will need these TWO triangles for this block.
Salmon	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/4" square.
Salmon	Cut ONE (1) 2 5/8" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner ONE (1) time. You will need these TWO (2) triangles for this block.
Blue	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/4" square.
Stripe	Cut ONE (1) 3" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner TWO (2) times. You will need TWO of the finished triangles for this block.
Stripe	Cut ONE (1) 2 5/8" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner ONE (1) time. You will need ONE (1) of these triangles for this block.
Ecru (beige)	Cut ONE (1) 3" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner TWO (2) times. You will need all FOUR (4) of the finished triangles for this block.
Ecru (beige)	Cut THREE (3) 2 1/4" squares.
Ecru (beige)	Cut ONE (1) 2 5/8" square - then cut your square diagonally, from corner-to-corner ONE (1) time. You will need ONE (1) of these triangles for this block.
Ecru (beige)	Cut TWO (2) 2 5/8" x 5 3/4" strips.




Vase of Flowers Block

1) Sew the small Green triangles to TWO (2) of the small ecru triangles, as shown. Press to the Green triangles:



2) Next, sew your Green/Ecru triangles to the Salmon triangles, as shown. Press to the Salmon triangles:



3) Repeat steps 1 & 2, this time using the small Stripe triangles and sewing them to the remaining TWO (2) small Ecru triangles ... then sewing these Stripe / Ecru triangles to the large Green triangles:



4) Sew the larger Stripe triangle to the larger Ecru triangle, as shown. Press toward the Stripe triangle:



5) Finally, lay your blocks out, as shown, and piece together! Press toward the red lines:
