March 2007 Block Set

Easter Basket Block - Fusible Web Appliqué



Fabric	Cut
Pink Waves	Cut ONE (1) 7 1/2" square
Fusible Web	Draw each template ONE (1) time onto your favorite fusible web. Then, iron onto the appropriate fabrics shown below and cut.
Blue	Cut ONE (1) from template C
Purple	Cut ONE (1) from template E
Green	Cut ONE (1) from template G
Brown	Cut ONE (1) each from template B, D & F

- 1) For this block, it is very helpful if you press your Pink Waves square TWO (2) times, folding it in half horizontally and then vertically, to give you guidelines on which to iron on your basket. Once you have your template pieces fused and cut, you can begin placing them on your Pink Waves square and ironing them on, per the fusible web manufacturer's instructions. A good way to do this, if you are a beginner, is to lay all of your pieces onto the block fabric first, making sure the seams all line up. Then, remove the fusible backing paper (discard) and press one template piece at a time to the Pink Waves block.
- 2) When all of your basket parts have been successfully ironed onto your Pink Waves square, use a blanket stitch or zig-zag stitch to appliqué each seam in place. You may want to use a stabilizer on the back, too.
