Fabrics



Fabric	Cut 1	Cut 2
Fabric A	Cut ONE (1) 12 1/8" square	n/a
Fabric B (note: you <i>*must*</i> cut out one square from this fabric, then cut into triangles...then use one of the triangles as a template to cut out the remaining FOUR (4) triangles -- they <i>will</i> all fit in a FQ, just watch the directions of the pattern in the fabric)	Cut ONE (1) 12 7/8" square	Cut square, corner-to-corner diagonally TWO (2) times. You will end up with FOUR (4) triangles. Then, use ONE (1) of these triangles as a template and cut out FOUR (4) more triangles from the fabric. Final count is EIGHT (8) total triangles.
Fabric C	Cut ONE (1) 12 7/8" square	Cut square, corner-to-corner diagonally TWO (2) times. You will end up with FOUR (4) triangles.
Fabric D	Cut EIGHT (8) 6 5/8" squares	Cut square, corner-to-corner diagonally ONE (1) time. You will end up with SIXTEEN (16) total triangles.
Fabric E	Cut FOUR (4) 4 5/8" squares	n/a
Fabric F	Cut TWO (2) 1 5/8" x width of fabric strips for binding.	With the remaining fabric, cut and piece it together so you have a 36" square for the backing.
Fabric G	Cut EIGHT (8) 6 3/8" squares	n/a
Fabric H	Cut TWO (2) 7" squares	Cut square, corner-to-corner diagonally TWO (2) times. You will end up with EIGHT (8) total triangles.
