	Fabric	Requirements Cuts	
	Floral Baby's Breath Pink	Cut ONE (1) 17 1/2" square	
	Paisley Fresh Blossom Light Green	Cut ONE (1) of the attached "Heart Center" template	
	Paisley Fresh Blossom Light Green	Cut TWO (2) of the attached "Heart Corrner" templates	
	Steam-a-Seam 2®	Cut the same number of templates as for the fabric above.	
	Aurifil™ thread applique color	#1154	


Prepare your Steam-a-Seam 2® by cutting out (about an inch larger) the attached "Heart Center" and "Heart Corner" templates. Following your manufacturers instructions, press the fusible web to the background block fabric. Finally, with your thread, secure the heart to your quilt block by using a blanket stitch (or a stitch of your preference).


The template has a seam allowance with the "Heart" for those who prefer to applique by hand. If you are using a fusible web and machine appliqueing, remember to follow the basic lines of the "Heart" template and ignore the seam allowance.
