"Shabby Love" Block #4

Fabric Cuts for "Shabby Love" Block #4		
Fabric	Requirements Cuts	
Floral Baby's Breath Pink	Cut ONE (1) 17 1/2" square	
Paisley Fresh Blossom Light Blue	Cut FOUR (4) of the attached templates	
Steam-a-Seam 2®	Cut the same number of templates as for the fabric above.	
Aurifil™ thread applique color	#1149	

Prepare your Steam-a-Seam 2® by cutting out (about an inch larger) the attached "Heart" templates. Following the manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the background block fabric. Finally, with your thread, secure the heart to your quilt block by using a blanket stitch (or a stitch of your preference) around the edges.

The template has a seam allowance for those who prefer to applique by hand. If you are using a fusible web and machine appliqueing, remember to follow the basic lines of the "Heart" template and ignore the seam allowance.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.
