Block #10—Precision Quilt Block



“Hometown Heroes” is a traditionally pieced block of the month (BOM) quilt using the Kimberbell Basics “Tiny Dots” fabrics designed by Kimberbell from Maywood Studio!

This quilt meets the requirements as a Quilts of Valor (QOV) Quilt! Make it for yourself or for a well deserving Veteran!

Finished quilt = 63” x 80 1/2”

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 15” Square


Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 15 1/2” Square

Make ONE (1)

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.



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Block #10—Precision Quilt Block—Cutting Instructions

| Fabric Color | Cut #1 | Cut #2 (if applicable) |
|--------------|-----------------------------|---|
| Red Dot | Cut TEN (10) 4 1/4” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| Blue Dot | Cut ONE (1) 3 1/2” square | N/A |
| Blue Dot | Cut SIX (6) 4 1/4” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| White Dot | Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square. |
| White Dot | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2” square | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square. |
| White Dot | Cut TWO (2) 4 7/8” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| White Dot | Cut TWO (2) 6 3/4” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square. |
| White Dot | Cut TWO (2) 7 3/8” squares | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square. |


Precision Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)





Trim to 3” sq.





Trim to 5 1/2” sq.





Trim to 3” sq.





Trim to 3” x 5 1/2”





Trim to 5 1/2” sq.





