



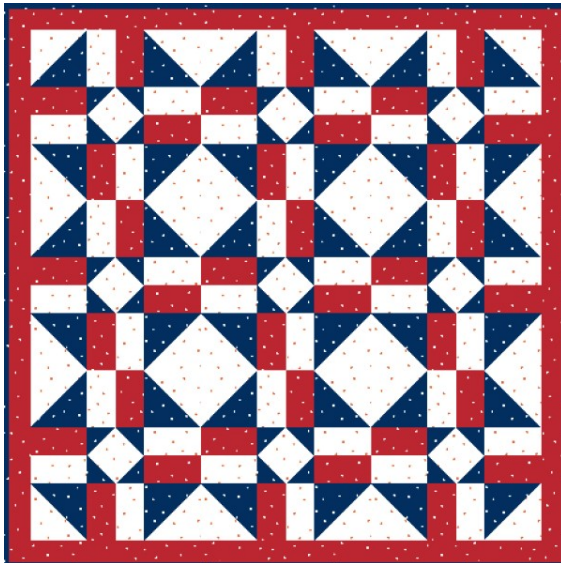

Finished quilt = 52" square
 Finished Blocks for Quilt = 16" square
 Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 16 1/2" square

All seams a scant 1/4"
 Press in the direction of the arrows.

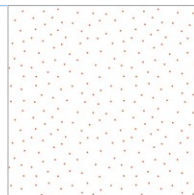
Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning

Fabric Requirements:

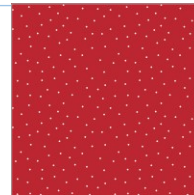
Fabric Color	Amount
Red Dot	1 3/4 yards (Includes Border)
Blue Dot	1 1/2 yards (Includes Binding)
White Dot	1 3/4 yards
Backing	3 1/3 yards

Also needed:

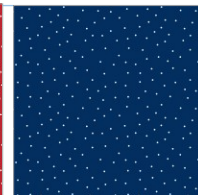
Cotton Batting (Such as Warm & Natural™)
 Coordinating Thread
 Starch or Mary Ellen's Best Press™
 Iron
 Rotary Cutter, Cutting Mat & Ruler

If you are making this quilt using the fabric yardage above, it is a good idea to cut the Border & Binding strips out before you cut the quilt block pieces out. That way you only have to piece them one or two times!

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right)

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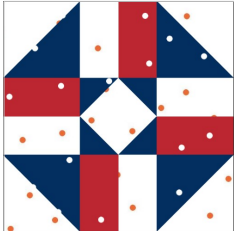
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“Crossroads” Quilt Block - Make NINE (9)

Cutting Instructions for NINE (9) “Crossroads” Quilt Blocks:

Fabric Color	Cut #1	Instructions and/or Cut #2
Red Dot	Cut THIRTY-SIX (36) 3 1/8" x 5 7/8" rectangles	N/A
Blue Dot	Cut EIGHTEEN (18) 3 3/4" squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
Blue Dot	Cut EIGHTEEN (18) 6 1/2" squares	N/A
White Dot	Cut THIRTY-SIX (36) 3 1/8" x 5 7/8" rectangles	N/A
White Dot	Cut EIGHTEEN (18) 6 1/2" squares	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.



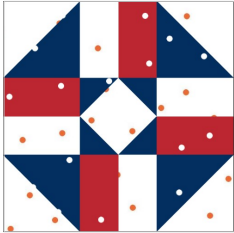
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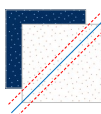

Tutorials

Half-Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial




HST - Figure #1



HST Figure #2

Place the lighter fabric square on top of the darker square (right sides together) & sew 1/4" on **EACH SIDE** of the drawn line (Blue & Red lines in **Figure #1**). Then **cut** the Half-Square Triangles (HST's) apart **ON** the drawn line. They'll yield TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles (**Figure #2**). Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip the corners (aka dog ears).

 **Quilt Note:** When making Half Square Triangles, try cutting the squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.

Square in a Square Tutorial

In my “Cutting Instructions” it'll say to cut some squares ONE (1) time diagonally, corner-to-corner. There will also be a larger square associated with it. When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for a Square in a Square follow the diagram on the left (**Figure #1**) **first**. Then follow the diagram on the right (**Figure #2**) **second**. Press in the direction of the arrows.

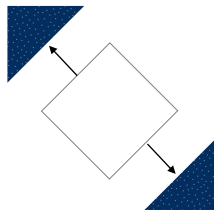

Sewing Instructions for the “Crossroads” Quilt Comfort Charity Quilt (cont.)

Fabric Cuts Needed to Finish the Quilt

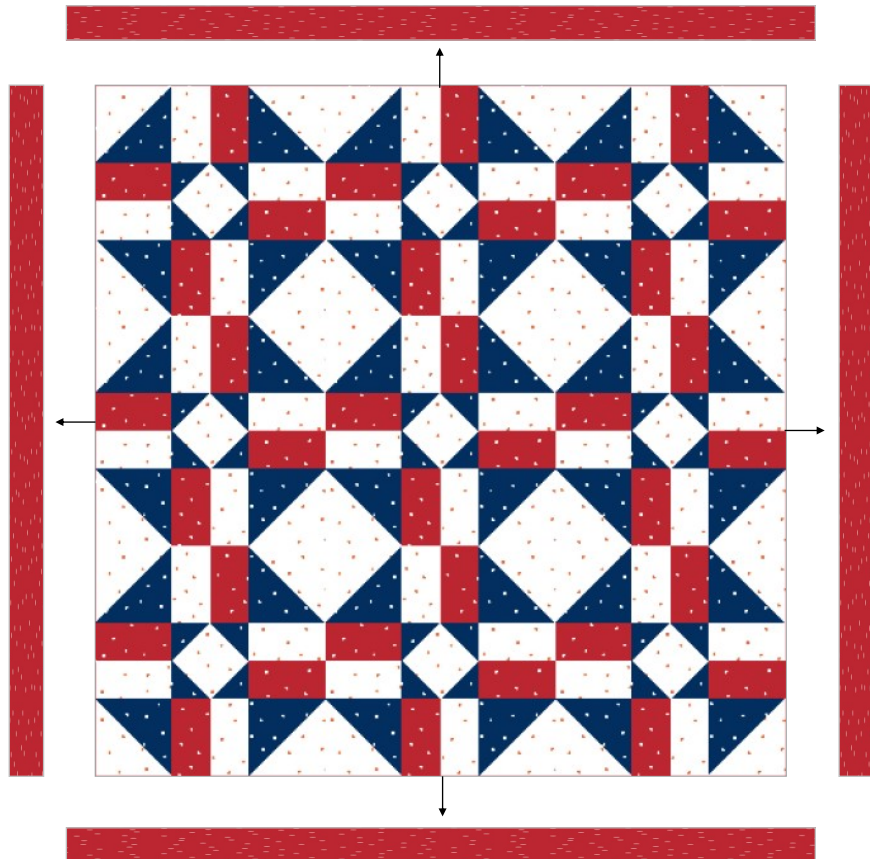
Red Dot	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border)
Red Dot	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border)
Blue Dot	Cut & piece TWO (2) 1" x WOF strips (Binding)

Congrats! From TK Harrison & Maywood Studio! Now quilt as desired then sew on the binding!

Be sure to cut the excess binding & backing fabrics off before you send it to be quilted!

This might be a great quilt to consider donating it to a veteran!
