

Finished Blocks to Measure 14" x 14"




Cutting Instructions for Block 7

Fabric A	Fabric B	Fabric C	Fabric D	Fabric E	Fabric F
Cut ONE (1) 5 1/2" square	Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares. Cut ONE (1) 3 1/8" square	Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares then cut this square diagonally ONE time.	Cut FOUR (4) 2 7/8" x 10 1/2" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below)	Cut THREE (3) 3 1/8" squares Cut FOUR (4) 2 7/8" squares	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/8" x 7 3/4" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below)

Measure over the SIDE size from edge and draw a diagonal line from the bottom corner to your mark. Repeat on opposite side

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
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
Sewing Instructions for Block 7

- Let's begin this month with some LINES! Draw a diagonal line, from corner-to-corner, on ONE (1) of your Fabric E 3 1/8" squares. Next, sew this Fabric E square to the right side of a Fabric B 3 1/8" squares, 1/4" and on BOTH sides of the line you drew. Then, cut your half-square triangles apart ON the diagonal line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles.
- 2) Cut the remaining TWO (2) Fabric E 3 1/8" squares in half, diagonally (corner-to-corner).
- Sew your four corner four-patch blocks from Fabrics B & C as shown. Repeat three more times for a total of FOUR (4) four-patch corners:






4) Cut the remaining TWO (2) Fabric E 3 1/8" squares in half diagonally, corner-to-corner. Sew the four corner four-patch blocks to the Fabric E triangles, as shown - make TWO (2) of these pieces:



5) Working with the final TWO (2) four-patch corner blocks, sew them to the Fabric E 2 7/8" squares and the half-square triangles you sewed above, as shown -- make TWO (2) of these pieces:



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

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Sewing Instructions for Block 7 (continued)

6) Now, assemble the rest of the center of your block:



- 7) Finally, complete the rest of your block!
- A -- sew 2 Fabric E strips to the left and right of your center half-square triangle square.
- B -- sew your 4 four-square blocks to the ends of 2 of your Fabric E strips.

C -- sew the four-square strips made in B above to the top and bottom of your center half-square triangle rectangle.

- D -- sew the 4 Fabric D strips to this center block.
- E -- sew the Fabric F strips to the long edge of your Fabric C triangles.
- F -- sew the center block to the corner triangles you made in E above!

Finished block will measure 14 5/8" square.



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Now, you're ready for Block 8!
