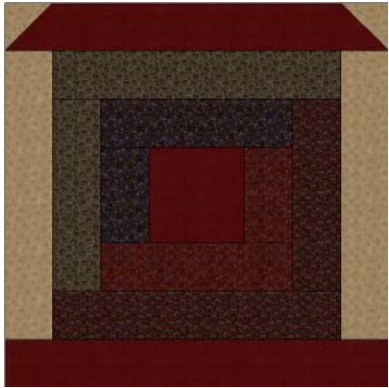

May 2007 Block Set

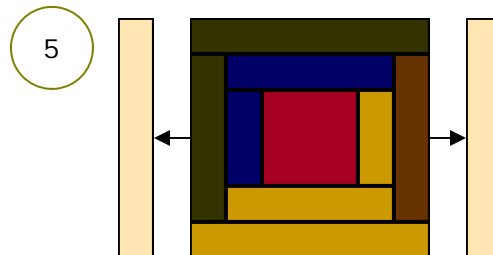
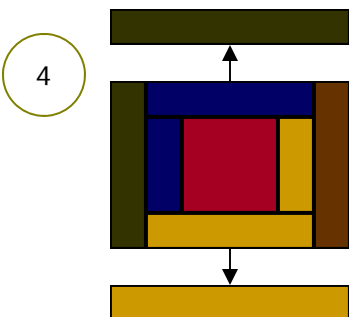
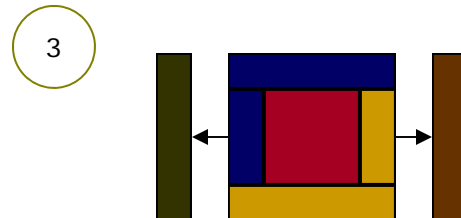
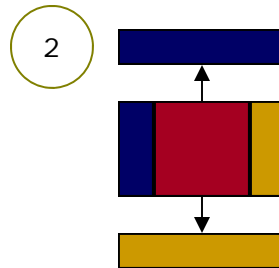
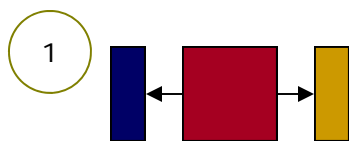


Beginners, Make THREE (3) of these blocks.

Fabric	Cut
Red	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/4" square
Red	Cut TWO (2) 1 3/8" x 7 1/2" strips
Ecru (beige)	Cut TWO (2) 1 3/8" x 5 3/4" strips
Ecru (beige)	Cut TWO (2) 1 3/8" squares, then draw a line diagonally, corner-to-corner ONE (1) time on the back of each.
Tan Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1 3/8" x 2 1/4" strip EACH COLOR
Tan Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1 3/8" x 4" strip EACH COLOR
Brown Green	Cut ONE (1) 1 3/8" x 4" strip EACH COLOR
Brown Green	Cut ONE (1) 1 3/8" x 5 3/4" strips of EACH COLOR

Birdhouse Block

- 1) Sew the birdhouse together, as shown. Press the first seam toward the Ecru triangle and the second seam toward the outside:

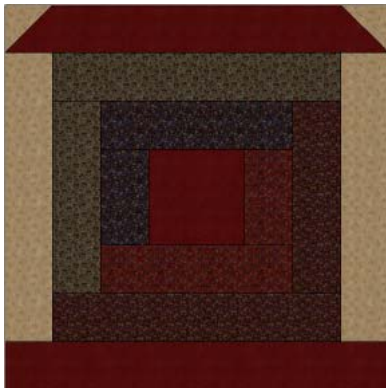

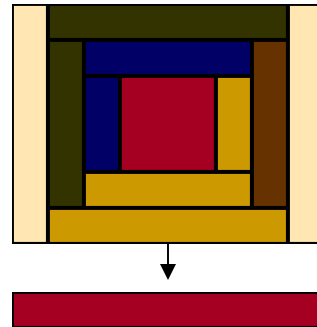

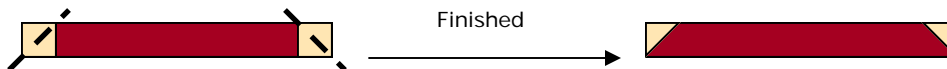


Birdhouse Block (continued)

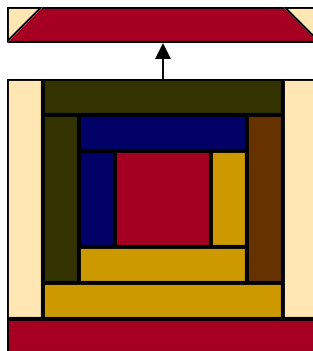

- 2) Using your remaining Red $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and the TWO (2) Ecru $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " strips, piece the corners to the Red strip, as shown and then cut away the corner $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the seam line. Press toward the red strip on both sides:



- 3) Now, add this "roof" to your birdhouse!
