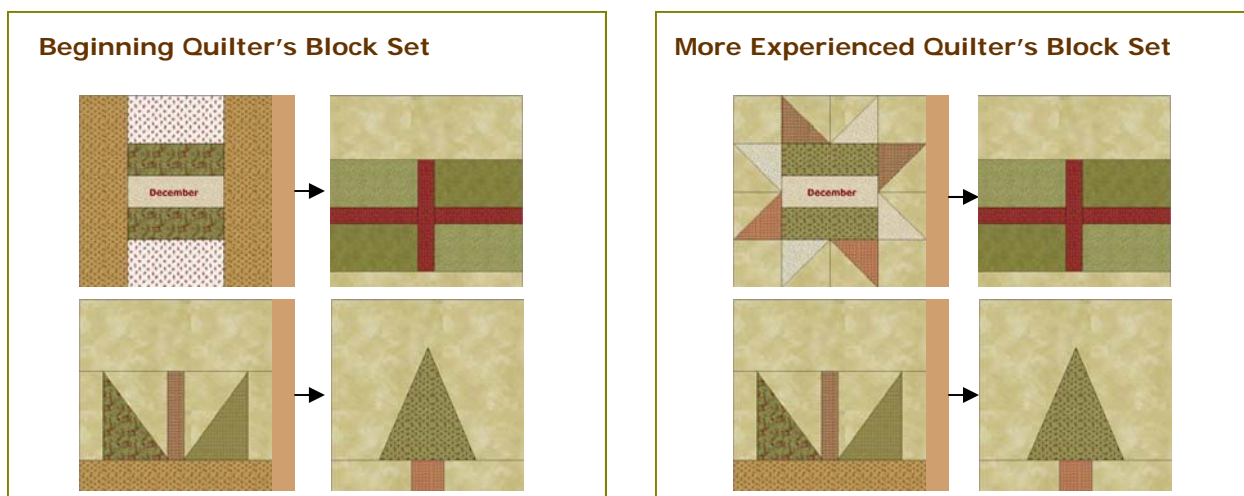
### Finishing the Quilt Calendar Block Set

	<table><tr><th>Fabric</th><th>Cut</th></tr><tr><td>Tan</td><td>Cut TWO (2) 1 5/8" x 7 1/2" strips</td></tr><tr><td>Tan</td><td>Cut THREE (3) 1 5/8" x width of fabric strips</td></tr><tr><td>Tan</td><td>Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips</td></tr></table>	Fabric	Cut	Tan	Cut TWO (2) 1 5/8" x 7 1/2" strips	Tan	Cut THREE (3) 1 5/8" x width of fabric strips	Tan	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips

- 1) Begin by sewing the short strips to the right sides of the two right blocks, pressing towards the Tan strips:



- 2) Now, sew your remaining blocks to these blocks, as shown, pressing towards the Tan strips:



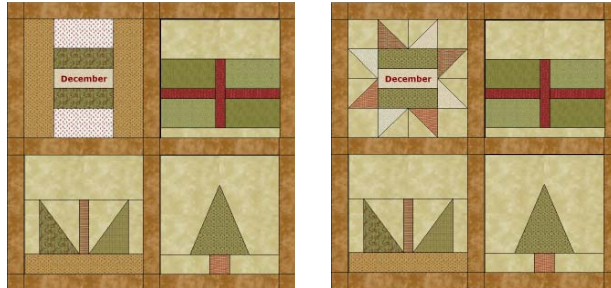

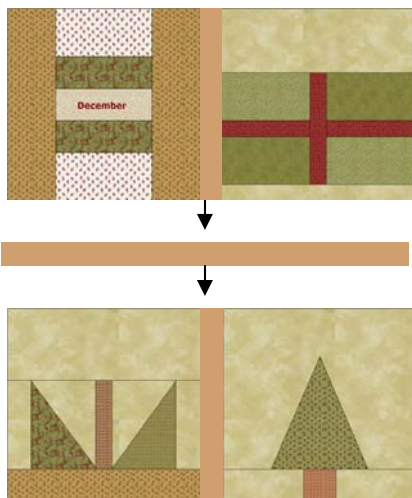
## November 2007 Block Set

### Finishing the Quilt Calendar Block Set (continued)

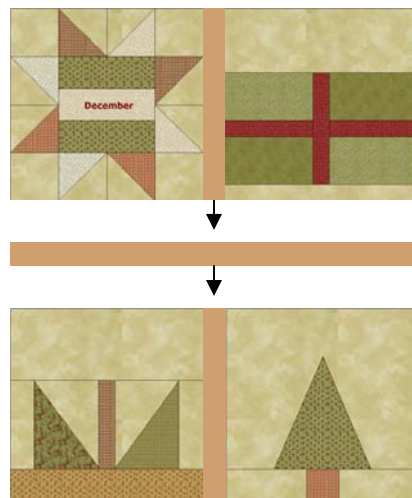


- Using one of the longer Tan strips, sew the two block rows together, as shown, pressing towards the Tan strip (cut the strip to-size after you sew it to the first row):

#### Beginning Quilter's Block Set

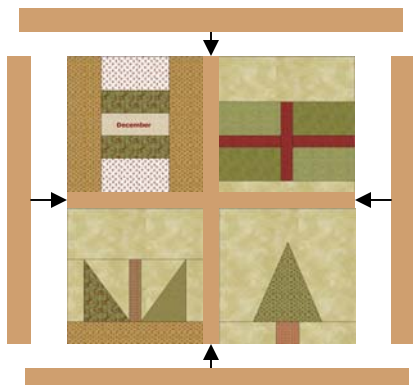


#### More Experienced Quilter's Block Set



- Finally, sew the left and right remaining Tan strips and then the top and bottom Tan strips, pressing towards the Tan last-sewn strips (cut the strip to-size after each side you sew):
