


Make a Calendar Quilt and/or Make a Quilt Calendar!

2007 BOM Project from BOMQuilts.com & AbbiMays.com November 2007 Block Set




Fabric	Cut
Sand	Cut TWO (2) 1 5/8" x 3 3/8" strips
Sand	Cut TWO (2) 7" squares
Green	Cut TWO (2) 5" squares (or use 1 charm square)
Red	Cut ONE (1) 1 5/8" square


NOTE: At BOMquilts.com, we embellished our calendar blocks with various ribbons. You may choose to do this, if you are making the calendar. If you are making the quilt, you probably do not want it to be 3D, so the online instructions will include PDF downloads so that you can use fusible webbing and the templates to appliqué the embellishments onto your blocks.



We're going to use the Sew n'Slash method to create your tree! With your Sand fabric, lay one of the green strips towards a corner and sew your seam allowance ON the line you drew. Once done, cut the excess fabric 1/4" of the seam and fold the green back and press. Now, square up your block so that it is 4" x 6 1/2". Repeat in the OP-POSITE direction with your Green strip for the second half of your tree.



Embellish your tree with either ribbon or some colored quilt stitches.
