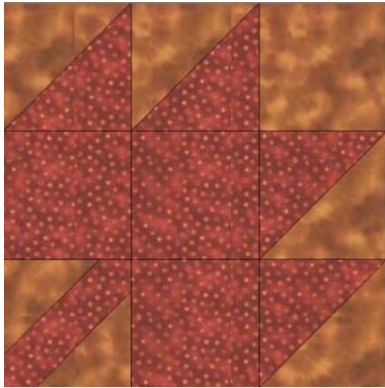


TT Calendar Quilt

October 2007 Block Set



Fabric	Cut
Tan	Cut TWO (2) 2 7/8" squares
Tan	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares
Red Dot	Cut THREE (3) 2 7/8" squares
Red Dot	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares
Red Dot	Cut ONE (1) 3 1/8" square

Maple Leaf Block #1

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Tan 3 1/8" squares, then sew, with right sides together, the Tan and Red Dot squares together on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Once done, cut apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles. Make TWO (2) of these, ending with FOUR (4) half-square triangles.
- 2) To make the stem, cut ONE (1) of the 2 7/8" Tan squares in half, diagonally.
- 3) Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of the final 3 1/8" Red Dot square. Then, measure over, on BOTH sides of this line 1/2" and cut. Remember, you'll be cutting this square TWO (2) times.
- 4) Now, sew the Tan triangles you cut in #2 above to the Red Dot strip you cut in #3 above, press toward the Red Dot fabric. If your square isn't exactly 2 7/8" square, trim accordingly:
- 5) Finally, put your block together, as shown, pressing toward the red lines:
