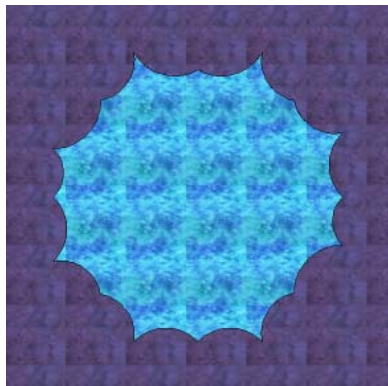


TT Calendar Quilt

September 2007 Block Set



Fabric	Cut
Purple	Cut ONE (1) 7 1/2" square
Blue	Cut ONE (1) spider web from template
Fusible Web	You'll need to trace the templates listed above onto the paper side of the fusible web, press to your appropriate fabrics, then cut all shapes out

Boo Web Block

- 1) Use the templates and trace the shapes onto your fusible web, then following the manufacturer's instructions, press onto your chosen fabrics. Once you have the fusible on your fabrics, use the image above as a guide you as you layer and press to your background fabrics.
- 2) Now, use your stitch of choice to appliqué the pieces onto your background fabric! At BOM-quilts.com, we chose to make this block with a raw edge appliqué. Basically, this means we wanted the raw edges of the fabric to be exposed, hence we placed top-stitching around each piece, but only to secure to the background fabric and not necessarily to hide the fun of the raw edges!
- 3) For embellishment, follow the pattern below with top-stitching or embroidery to give this Boo Web it's tell-tale webbing!
