

Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 9 1/2"

Purchase Aurifil Thread from Aurifil

All seams a scant 1/4".

Press in the direction of the arrows.

Finishing Instructions Part #1

If your rows do not come out all the same length, do not worry! According to my calculations, they should all be the same length. But even at that, a couple of mine didn't come out the same length, either.

Just add equal amounts on each end of white or whatever scrappy fabric you have that will match the rows that are too short.

White 1 yard

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right)

Part Two for Row #5

Fabric Cuts for Finishing Instructions Part #1	
Color	Cuts
White	Cut & Piece SEVEN (7) 2 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips.

The strips you cut are for the sashing between the rows. Sew each sashing to the top or bottom of each row, pressing toward the sashing. The repeat the same process for the next row. The **only two rows** you will not sew two strips of sashing to will be the top and bottom rows (Log Cabin Blocks), where you will just sew one strip of sashing to each of them.

In order to keep your fabric from curving, remember to sew your sashing in opposite directions. If you sewed the sashing from left to right on top Log Cabin row, sew the sashing to the four-patch row from right to left (see below). Repeat for each and every sashing strip you add to the quilt top.
