Finished quilt = 59" Square
 Finished Blocks for Quilt = 14" Square | Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 14 1/2" Square

Block #4 - Whirlpool



Whirlpool Quilt Block

Fabric Color	Cuts
Stars White/Red	Cut SIX (6) 4 1/2" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. TWO (2) of these will be paired with the Floral Tossed Main Navy 4 1/2" squares. FOUR (4) of these will be paired with the Lattice Red 4 1/2" squares. All SIX (6) of them will create half-square triangles.
Tiny Rose Navy	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" square. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. These will be paired with TWO (2) of the of the Lattice Red 4 1/2" quilt squares to create half-square triangles.
Lattice Red	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" squares. TWO (2) of these will be paired with the Tiny Rose Navy 4 1/2" squares. The remaining TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares will be paired with the Stars White/Red 4 1/2" squares to create half-square triangles.
Floral Tossed Main Navy	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" squares. These will be paired with the Stars White/Red 4 1/2" quilt squares to create half-square triangles.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

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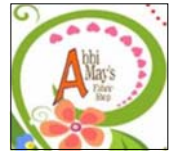

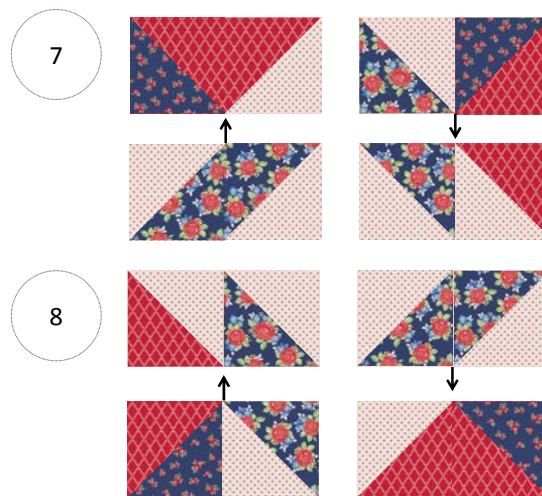
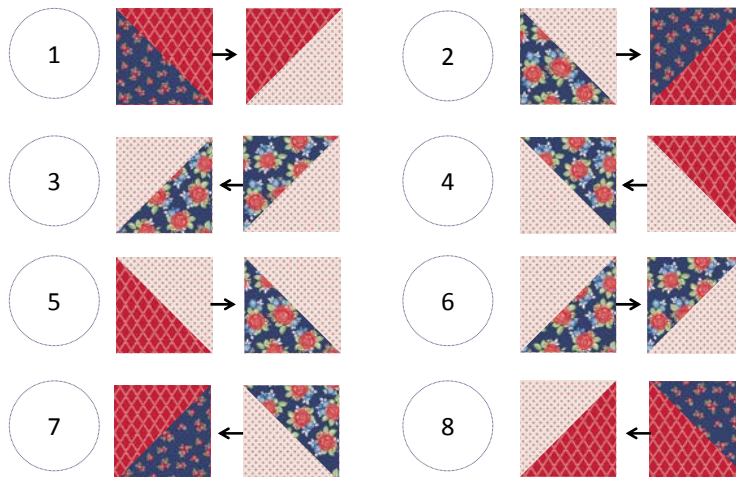
Whirlpool Quilt Block



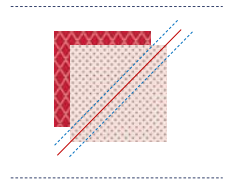
Quilt Note: When making half-square triangles, try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.

In the case of the "Whirlpool Quilt Block," you need to trim the half-square triangles down so they are 4" square.

Press in the direction of the arrows.



Half-Square Triangle Tutorial



Place the Stars Red/White 4 1/2" square on the Lattice Red 4 1/2" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew.

You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles.

Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).

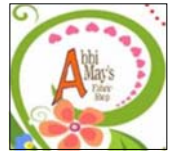
Repeat this technique for remaining half-square triangles for this quilt block.



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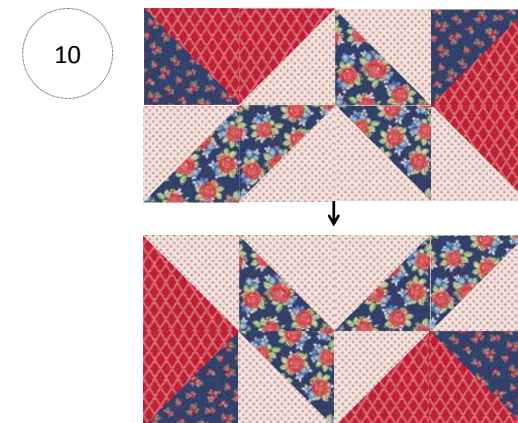
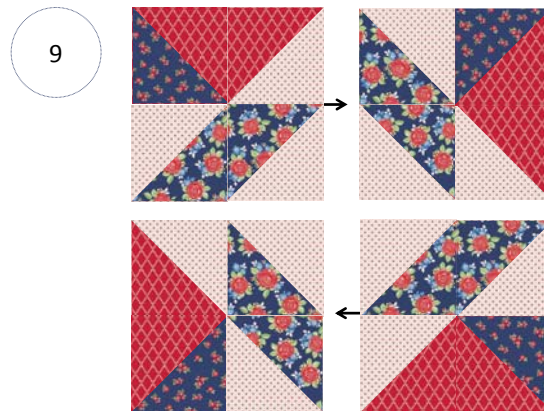

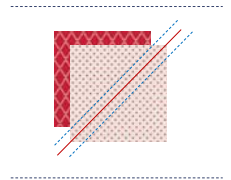
