Block #5 - Hovering Hawks



Hovering Hawks

	Fabric Color	Cuts
	Tiny Rose Navy	Cut FOUR (4) 4" squares
	Lattice Red	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares. These will be paired with TWO (2) of the Stars White/Navy 4 1/2" squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles.
	Ticking Cream/Green	Cut THREE (3) 4 1/2" squares. These will be paired with THREE (3) of the Stars White/Navy 4 1/2" squares to create SIX (6) half-square triangles.
	Stars White/Navy	Cut TWO (2) 4" squares
	Stars White/Navy	Cut FIVE (5) 4 1/2" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. TWO (2) of these will be paired with the Lattice Red 4 1/2" squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. THREE (3) of these will be paired with the Ticking Cream/Green 4 1/2" squares to create SIX (6) half-square triangles.






Quilt Note: When making half-square triangles, try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.


In the case of the "Hovering Hawks Quilt Block," you need to trim the half-square triangles down so the are 4" square.

Press in the direction of the arrows.



Half-Square Triangle Tutorial



Place the Ticking Cream/ Green 3 3/4" square on the Stars White/Navy 3 3/4" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then cut the halfsquare triangles apart ON the line you drew.

You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles.

Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).

Repeat this technique for remaining half-square triangles, paying attention to the colors of the fabrics, for this quilt block.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.
