## Block \#6 - Old Maid’s Puzzle

| Fabric Color | Cuts |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |

Quilt Note: You may have to piece your Tiny Rose Navy squares and your Tiny Rose Cream/Red, if you find you have run out of enough fabric to make the full squares as-is.

This pattem has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the comect block size.

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## Block \#6 - Old Maid's Puzzle (continued)



Old Maid's Puzzle Quilt Block

Quilt Note: When making half-square triangles, try cutting your squares $1 / 4$ " or $1 / 2^{\text {" l larger than }}$ the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.

In the case of the "Old Maid's Puzzle Quilt Block," you need to trim the half-square triangles down so the are 4" square.


Make TWO (2)

Half-Square Triangle
Place the Tiny Rose
Cream/Red $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
on the Blue Ticking $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
square (right sides togeth-
er) and sew $1 / 4 "$ on EACH
SIDE of the line you drew.
Then cut the half-square
triangles apart ON the line
you drew.
You will end up with TWO
(2) half-square triangles.
Press toward the darkest
fabric. Clip your corners
(aka dog ears).
Repeat this technique for
remaining half-square
triangles for this quilt
block.
