## Block \#8 - Flying X



Flying X Quilt Block

| Fabric Color | Cuts |
| :--- | :--- |
| Lattice Blue | Cut FOUR (4) $4 \prime \prime$ squares |
| Stars Red/White | Cut FOUR (4) $4 \prime$ " squares |
| Stars Red/White | Cut TWO (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. These will be paired with the Stars Blue/Navy <br> $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. |
| Tiny Rose Navy | Cut TWO (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. These will be paired with the Stars Blue/Navy <br> $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. |
| Stars Blue/Navy | Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diago- <br> nal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. TWO (2) of these will be paired with <br> the Stars Red/White 4 1/2" squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. <br> The remaining TWO (2) will be paired with the Tiny Rose Navy $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ <br> squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. |

Quilt Note: You may have to piece your Tiny Rose Navy squares, if you find you have run out of enough fabric to make the full squares as-is.

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## Block \#8 - Flying X (continued)



Flying X Quilt Block

Quilt Note: When making half-square triangles, try cutting your squares $1 / 4$ " or $1 / 2^{\text {" }}$ larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.

In the case of the "Flying X Quilt Block," you need to trim the half-square triangles down so the are 4 " square.

Press in the direction of the arrows.

Place the Stars Red/White $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the Stars Navy/Blue 4 1/2" square (right sides together) and sew $1 / 4$ " on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew.

You will end up with TWO
(2) half-square triangles.

Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).

Repeat this technique for remaining half-square triangles, paying attention to the fabric colors, for this quilt block.
