







Brown Sugar



Cream



Sandcastle



Leather & Lace



Mellow Yellow



Black



#### Block #2 - Part #2 - Piecing the "Stockyard Star" Quilt Blocks Together (cont.)



"Stockyard Star"
Quilt Block
Make a total of FIVE (5)



HST - Figure #1

Half-Square Triangle (QST) Tutorial





**HST Figure #2** 

Place the Cream 2 3/4" square on the Black 2 3/4" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (Figure #1). Then cut the half-square triangles apart <u>ON</u> the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).



Quilt Note: When making HST's and/or QST's, try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block. In the case of the "Stockyard Star" quilt block, the exact finished size should be 2 1/2" square.

#### **Flying Geese Tutorial**

You will see on my instructions to either cut some squares one time or two times. Both of them diagonally, corner-to-corner. When piecing a Flying Geese for the "Stockyard Star" quilt block, follow Diagram #1 on the left first (sewing the TWO (2) Leather & Lace triangles to the same-sized Brown Sugar triangles). Then follow Diagram #2 on the right (sewing the larger Black triangle to the newly created Leather & Lace/Brown Sugar triangles). The exact finished size of the Flying Geese for the "Stockyard Star" quilt blocks is 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Quilt Note: If you are making a quilt block that has a lot of Flying Geese in it, is best if you press all of your Flying Geese seams open.





After you've sewn the Half-Square Triangles & the Flying Geese together. These are just Nine-Patch quilt blocks!




Make a total of TEN (10)
