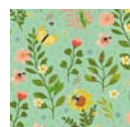

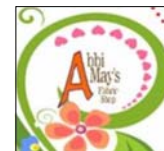


Girl's Favorite #4
Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)

There'll be leftover fabrics after sewing the "Girl's Favorite" quilt blocks together. Don't toss them in your scrap bin! You'll need them for future "Graceful Garden" quilt blocks!

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.

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Girl's Favorite – Blocks #3 & #4 – Cutting Requirements



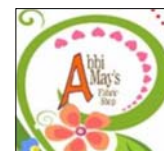
Girl's Favorite #3
Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)

Cream Dot	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares. On the back side draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
Cream Dot	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/4" squares.
Light Pink Plaid	Cut FOUR (4) 5 3/4" squares.
Mint Medium Floral	Cut FOUR (4) 5" squares.
Orange Diagonal Plaid	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares.
Teal Large Floral	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares.



Girl's Favorite #4
Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)

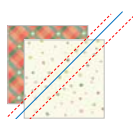
Cream Dot	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares. On the back side draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
Cream Dot	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/4" squares.
Light Pink Plaid	Cut FOUR (4) 5 3/4" squares.
Mint Medium Floral	Cut FOUR (4) 5" squares.
Orange Diagonal Plaid	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares.
Teal Large Floral	Cut TWO (2) 5 3/8" squares.

Half-Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial



HST Figure #2

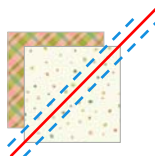
Place the Cream Dot 5 3/8" square on the Orange Diagonal Plaid 5 3/8" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (Figure #1). Then cut the Half-Square Triangles (HST's) apart ON the line you drew. You'll end up with TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears). Repeat the same process for the Cream Dot 5 3/8" squares & the Teal Large Floral 5 3/8" squares. The finished size's a 4 1/2" square.



Quilt Note: When making Half Square Triangles, try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block. You need a **total of FOUR (4)** of these HST's for ONE (1) "Girl's Favorite" quilt blocks!

Quarter-Square Triangle (QST) Tutorial

First make a Half-Square Triangle (HST). Place the Cream Dot 5 3/4" square on the Light Pink Diagonal Plaid 5 3/4" square (right sides together) & sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (shown in **blue** in Figure #1 below). Then cut the Half-Square Triangles apart ON the line you drew (shown in **red** in Figure #1 below). You'll end up with TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles. Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears). The finished size's a 4 1/2" square.



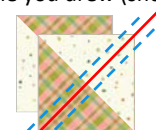

HST Finished

On the back side of one of the HST's, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner ONE (1) time (shown in **red** in Figure #2 below). Nestle the TWO (2) HST squares together (opposite colors nestled against opposite colors) & sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (shown in **blue** in Figure #2 below). Cut them apart ON the line that you drew (shown in **red** in Figure #2 below).

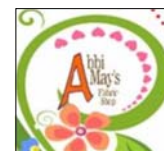

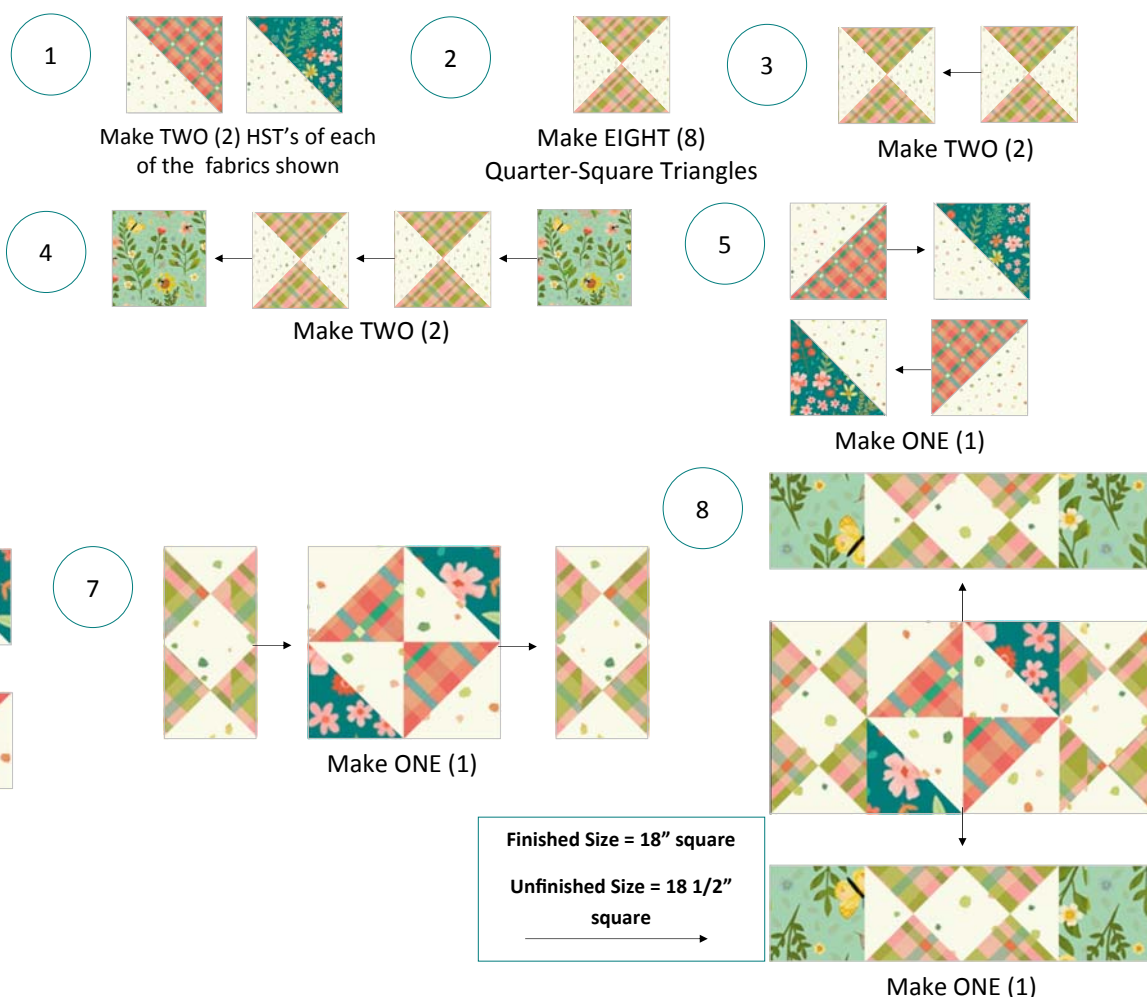
Quarter-Square Triangle (QST) Tutorial (cont.)

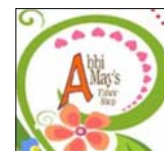
Once you’ve cut them apart, then on the back side, you want to swirl the center seam. You do this by popping open the first couple of stitches. This allows you to open it & get the square to lay very flat (read: the seams will lay down better). Check out this short tutorial to see how to swirl your QST: <https://www.bonjourquilts.com/seamswirl/>. Then trim it down to the exact size that you need for your quilt block.

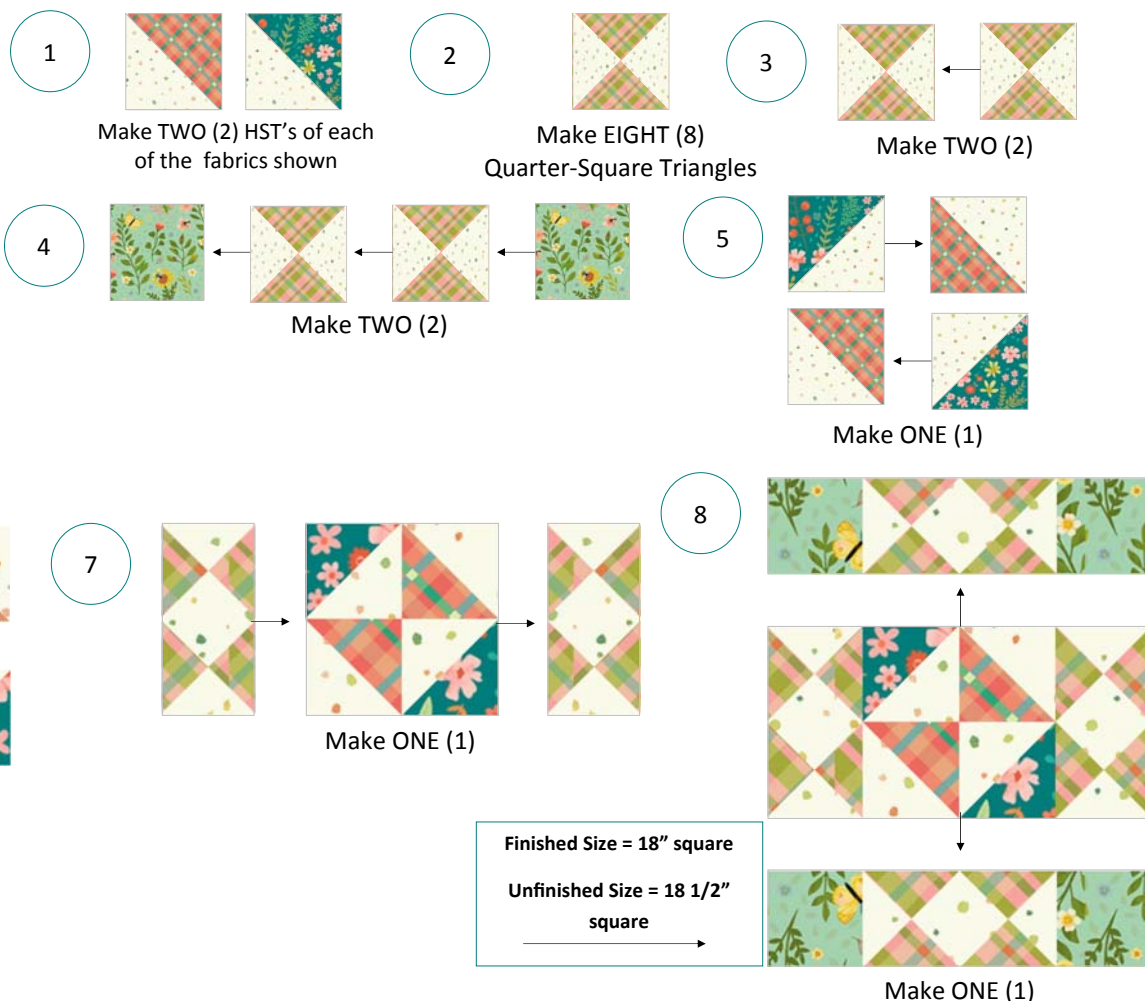
