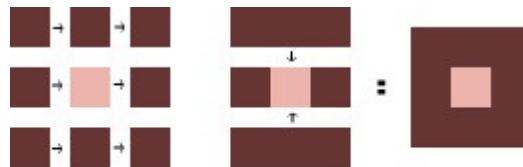
### Sashing & Border Instructions:

### Cutting Instructions:

*Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:
2 (pink)	2-1/2" Square	24
5 (dk brown)	2-1/2" x 15-1/2" Strip	31
5 (dk brown)	2-1/2" Square	32
6 (Large Floral)	6-1/2" x 53-1/2" Strip (cut lengthwise strip from fabric)	2
6 (Large Floral)	6-1/2" x 70-1/2" Strip (cut lengthwise strip from fabric)	2
5 (dk brown)	2 1/2" x WOF Strips (Binding)	8

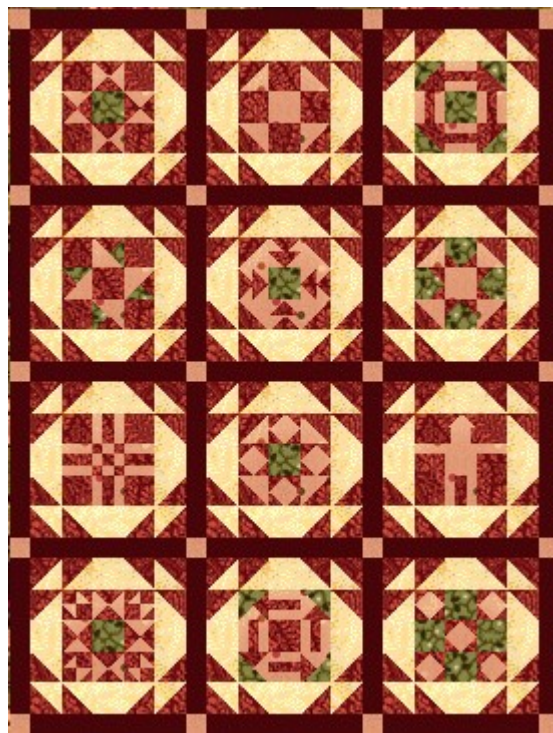
## Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Using FOUR (4) Fabric 2 (pink) 2-1/2" squares and the Fabric 5 (dk. brown) 2-1/2" squares, sew the Cornerstone blocks as shown below:



*Make four corner blocks*

**Step 2:** Lay out the 15-1/2" blocks, Fabric 5 (dk brown) 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips, and the remaining Fabric 2 (pink) 2-1/2" squares as shown in the quilt below.

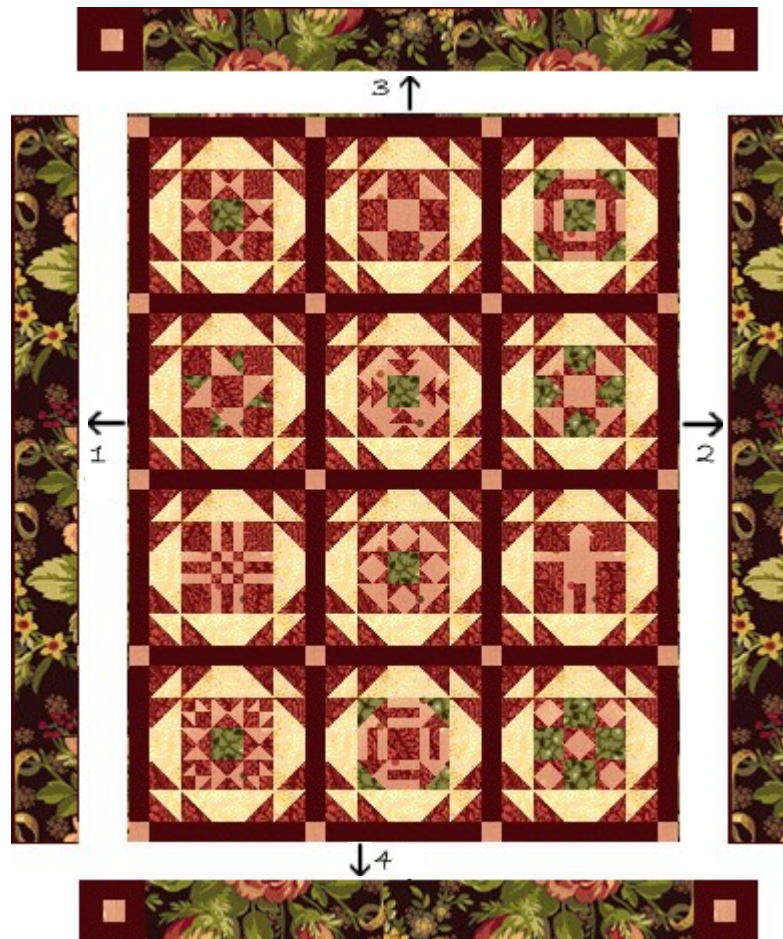


**Step 3:** Sew into horizontal rows, then sew rows to complete the center of the quilt. Press seams toward the Sashing.

**Step 4:** Sew a Cornerstone blocks (Step 1) to each end of a Fabric 6 (large floral) 6-1/2" x 53-1/2" Strip. Press seams away from the corner blocks. Make TWO (2).



**Step 5:** Using the diagram below as your guide, add the Fabric 6 (large floral) 6-1/2" x 70-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the Fabric 6 strips. Add the Step 4 strips to the top and bottom to finish the quilt. Press seams toward the Fabric 6 strips.



### Finishing:

Layer your backing, batting & quilt top. Baste your quilt & bind as desired.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.
