Finished quilt = 63” x 80 1/2”

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 15” Square

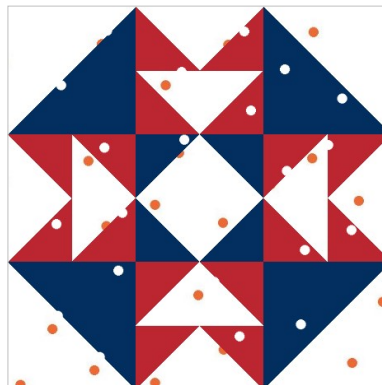
Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 15 1/2” Square

All seams a scant 1/4”

### Block #11—Flying T Quilt Block—Cutting Instructions

Fabric Color	Cut #1	Cut #2 (if applicable)
Red Dot	Cut EIGHT (8) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
Blue Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
Blue Dot	Cut TWO (2) 7 5/8” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut ONE (1) 3 1/2” square	N/A
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2” square	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 4 7/8” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 6 3/4” squares	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 7 3/8” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.

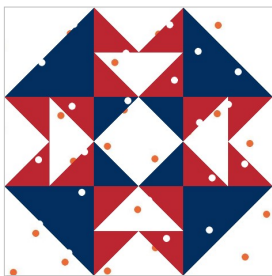

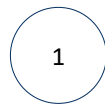

### Block #11—Flying T Quilt Block—Sewing Instructions

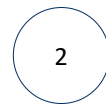


Flying T Quilt Block  
Make ONE (1)



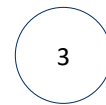

Make ONE (1)  
Square in a Square  
Trim to 5 1/2" sq.

Make FOUR (4)  
Half-Square  
Triangles  
Trim to 5 1/2" sq.



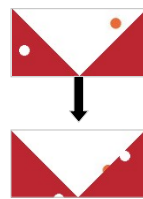

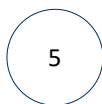
Make TWO (2)  
Flying Geese  
Trim to 3 1/2" x  
5 1/2" sq.



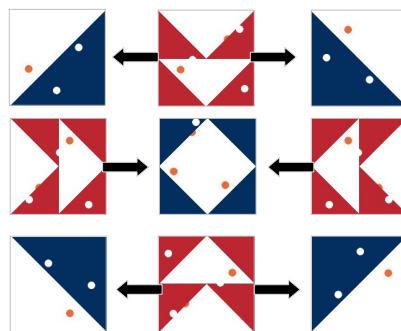

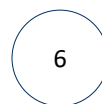
Make FOUR (4)  
Trim to 5 1/2" sq.



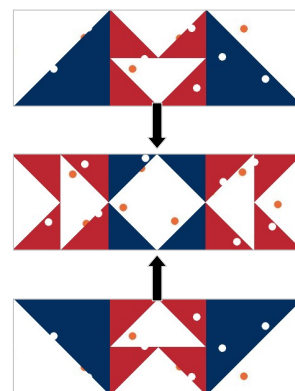

Trim all  
components to 5 1/2" sq.

Unfinished Size =
