### Block #6—Envelope Quilt Block

Finished quilt = 63" x 80 1/2"

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 15" Square

Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 15 1/2" Square

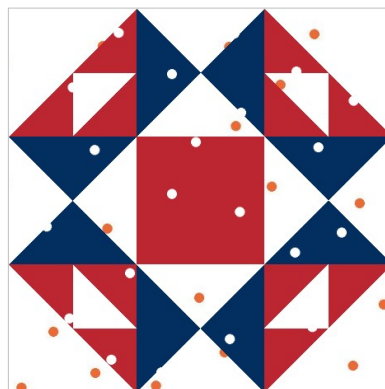

### Block #6—Envelope Quilt Block—Cutting Instructions

Fabric Color	Cut #1	Cut #2 (if applicable)
Red Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 6” square	N/A
Red Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
Red Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares	N/A
Blue Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 7 3/8” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square.

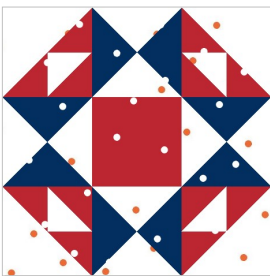

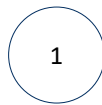

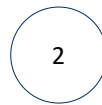
Envelope Quilt Block

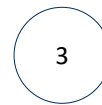
Make FOUR (4)

Trim to 3" x 5 1/2"

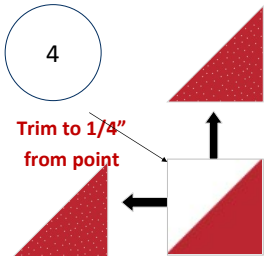
Make FOUR (4)

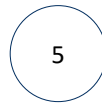
Make FOUR (4)

Trim to 3" sq.



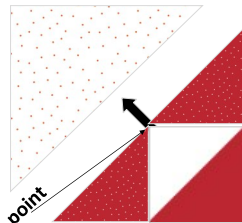

Make FOUR (4)

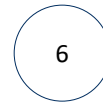

from point

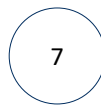
Make FOUR (4)  
Trim to 5 1/2" sq.



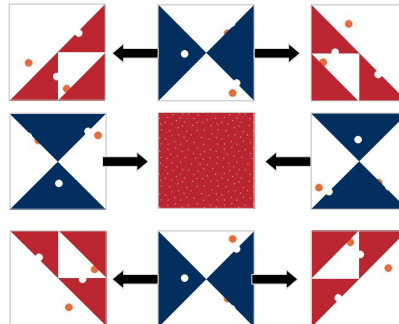

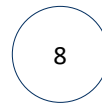
Make FOUR (4)

Trim to 5 1/2" sq.



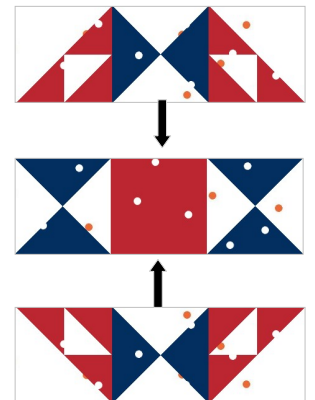
