Block #7—Aunt Susie’s Quilt Block



“Hometown Heroes” is a traditionally pieced block of the month (BOM) quilt using the Kimberbell Basics “Tiny Dots” fabrics designed by Kimberbell from Maywood Studio!

This quilt meets the requirements as a Quilts of Valor (QOV) Quilt! Make it for yourself or for a well deserving Veteran!

Finished quilt = 63” x 80 1/2”

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 15” Square

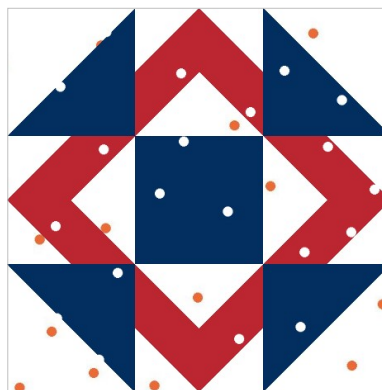
Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 15 1/2” Square

All seams a scant 1/4”

Press in the direction of the arrows

Aunt Susie’s Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.



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Block #7 –Aunt Susie’s Quilt Block–Cutting Instructions

Fabric Color	Cut #1	Cut #2 (if applicable)
Red Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
Red Dot	Cut ONE (1) 7 3/8” square	Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles.
Blue Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares	N/A
Blue Dot	Cut ONE (1) 6” square	N/A
Blue Dot	Cut TWO (2) 6 3/4” squares	N/A
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4” squares	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White Dot	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut TWO (2) 6 3/4” squares	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.
White Dot	Cut ONE (1) 7 3/8” square	Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles.

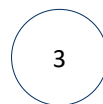
Aunt Susie’s Quilt Block
Make ONE (1)



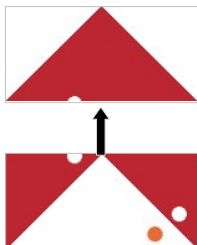
Make FOUR (4)
Half-Square
Triangles
Trim to 3” sq.



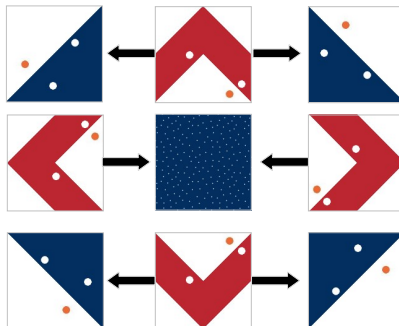
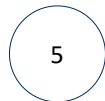
Make FOUR (4)
Flying Geese
Trim to 3” x 5 1/2”



Make FOUR (4)
Flying Geese
Trim to 3” x 5 1/2”

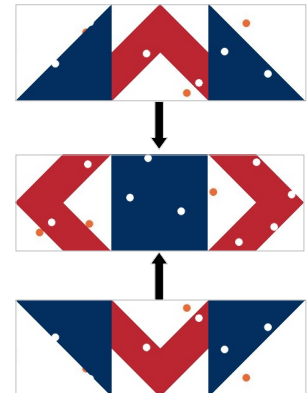
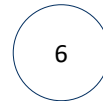


Make FOUR (4)
Trim to 5 1/2” sq.



Make ONE (1)

Trim all
components to 5 1/2” sq.



Make ONE (1)
Unfinished Size =
15 1/2” sq.
