

July 2008 Instructions

Completed Quilt Size: 60" square


Block Size: 9 1/2" finished, 10" unfinished

1/4" seam allowance



You'll notice when you get your panel fabric, that two of the panels are shorter than the other four. For the July instructions, let's piece them to-size. For this, you'll need to cut out the two (Jingle Bells and the Royal Ornaments) panels at 10" wide and approximately 7 1/2" in height. Then, find the red layer cake square that is all red, and looks like patchwork, and cut it out so that you end up with FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 10" strips.



Using TWO (2) of the strips you cut, per panel block, sew them to the top and bottom of the panel block. Press in the direction of the arrows. Now, square up the block so it is 10" square.



Cut TWO strips of gold fusible bias tape, 11" in length. Press one to EACH seam line you just made, making sure you tuck the extra around to the back of the block. Then, using a blanket stitch (or a decorative stitch of your choice), secure the gold bias tape to the block.



Remember to do this for BOTH of the shorter blocks from your panel, the Jingle Bells panel block and the Royal Ornaments panel Block.
