2008 Free "Christmas in July" 6 Month BOM Quilt Patterns from BOMQuilts.com & AbbiMays.com

November 2008 Instructions

Completed Quilt Size: 60" square

Block Size: 9 1/2" finished, 10" unfinished

1/4" seam allowance

Fabric Yardage - from AbbiMays.com "Royal Holiday" by Deb Strain from Moda







This is a layered block, with TWO (2) layer cakes. Begin by choosing the two layer cakes shown below:





Now, place the green square on top of the lighter square, with the right sides BOTH facing up, and baste around the edges, 1/8" from the edges, so they become one square.



It's time to add your gold fusible bias tape, in the shape of a Christmas flower (see the attached page with the template). Once you've cut and pressed your gold into place, use a blanket stitch (or a decorative stitch of your choice), secure the gold bias tape to the block.



Hint: It helps to fold your square in half both directions, to find the center for your template.

Finally, using a fabric-safe marking pencil or marker, draw a line about 1/4" on the INSIDE of the golden flower, and cut out the center of the GREEN (front) fabric, to expose a raw edge and to expose the light fabric underneath.
