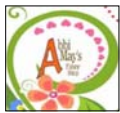

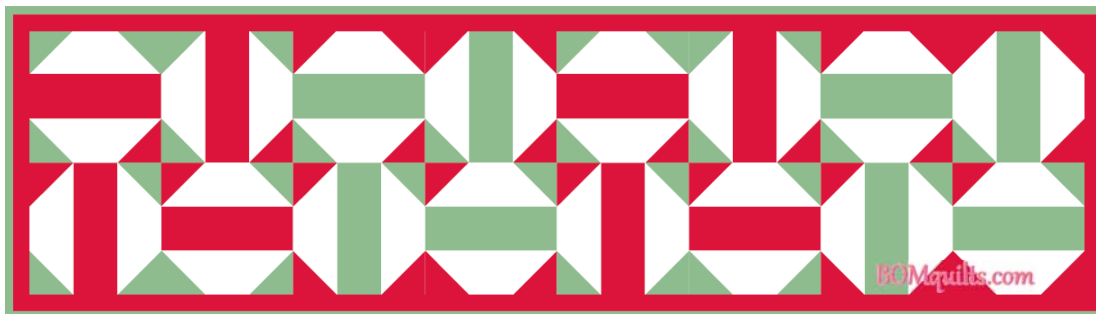

## "Ornament's Table Runner"

Finished Size = 9" x 33"

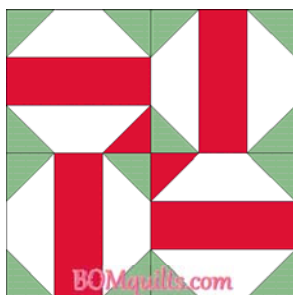
Block Size = 8" finished & 8 1/2" unfinished

This is the perfect project for an advanced beginner! It's all about Snowball Corners with this "Ornament's Table Runner" and if you can master them (or are willing to learn how to do it) it will sew together quickly!

### Fabric Requirements for the "Ornament's Table Runner" shown above (including Binding)

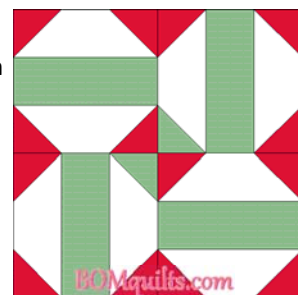
|       |                             |
|-------|-----------------------------|
| Red   | 1/4 yard (includes Border)  |
| Green | 1/4 yard (includes Binding) |
| White | 1/2 yard                    |

There are TWO (2) different quilt blocks that make up the "Ornament's Table Runner". The best way to sew them together is by chain piecing each block:

1. Sew the Red or Green Snowball Corners to the White strips first.
2. Then sew the Red or Green center strips to the White strips. This will create a quadrant.
3. Next sew the quadrants into rows.
4. Finally sew the rows into the rows into quilt blocks.

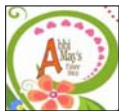

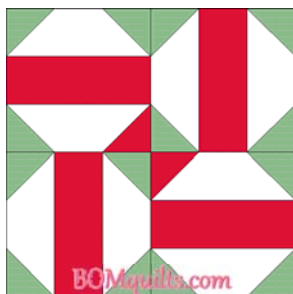
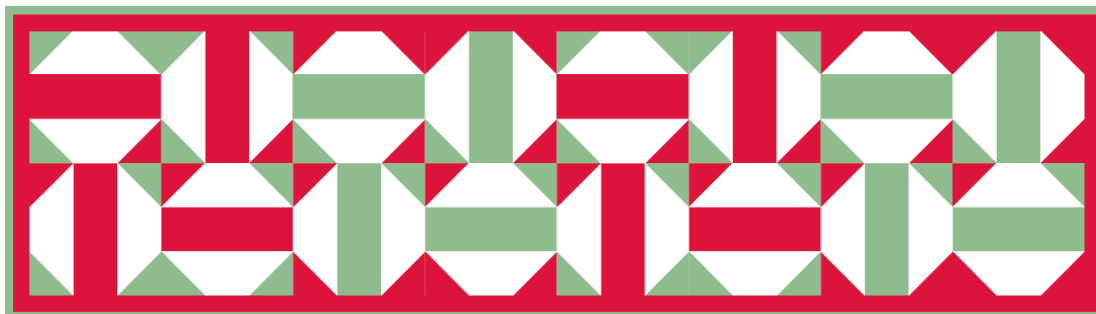

### Cuts Needed for the “Ornament’s Quilt Block” With Green Snowball Corners

| Color | Cuts  |
|-------|---|
| Green | Cut TWENTY-EIGHT (28) 2" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. (These will be paired with the White 5 1/4" squares and will create FOURTEEN (14) Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)   |
| Red   | Cut FOUR (4) 2" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. (These will be paired with FOUR (4) of the White 5 1/4" squares and will create FOUR (4) of the Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)  |
| Red   | Cut EIGHT (8) 1 3/4" x 4 1/2" strips. (These will be flanked on both sides, by the White 5 1/4" strips, and will be the center of each “ornament”, as needed for the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)  |
| White | Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/4" strips. (TEN (10) of these will be paired with the Green 2" squares, and the remaining FOUR (4) will be paired with the Red 2" squares on one end and the Green 2" squares on the other end, and will create a total of THIRTY-TWO (32) Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.) |

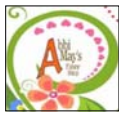

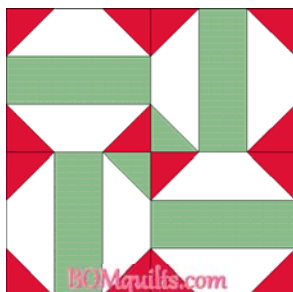
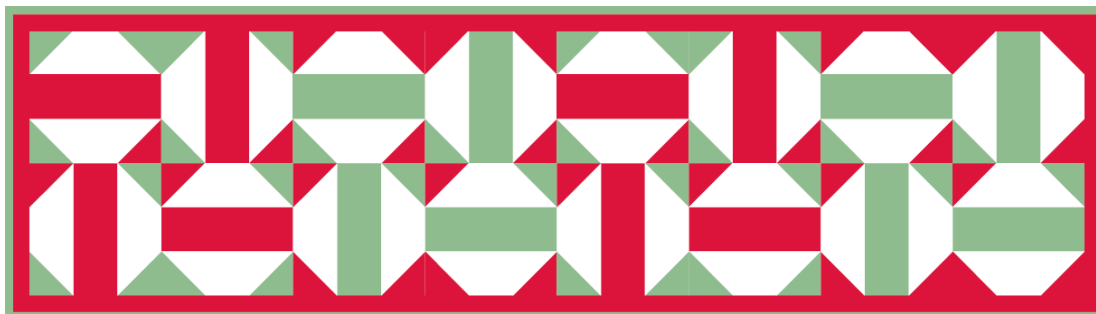

**“Ornament’s Quilt  
Blocks”  
With Red Snowball  
Corners**  
With Make TWO (2)

Finished Size = 8”  
Unfinished Size =  
8 1/2”

### Cuts Needed for the “Ornament’s Table Runner”

| Color | Cuts  |
|-------|---|
| Red   | Cut TWENTY-EIGHT (28) 2" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. (These will be paired with the White 5 1/4" squares and will create FOURTEEN (14) Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)   |
| Green | Cut FOUR (4) 2" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. (These will be paired with the White 5 1/4" squares and will create FOUR (4) of the Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)  |
| Green | Cut EIGHT (8) 1 3/4" x 4 1/2" strips. (These will be flanked on both sides, by the White 5 1/4" strips, and will be the center of each “ornament”, as needed for the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.)  |
| White | Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/4" strips. (TEN (10) of these will be paired with the Red 2" squares, and the remaining FOUR (4) will be paired with the Red 2" squares on one end and the Green 2" squares on the other end, and will create a total of THIRTY-TWO (32) Snowball Corners for TWO (2) of the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks”.) |

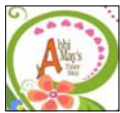
In case you didn’t notice it, both the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks” with the Green Snowball Corners and the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks” with the Red Snowball Corners, have the same number of cuts and directions.  
The only difference is that they’re in reverse!

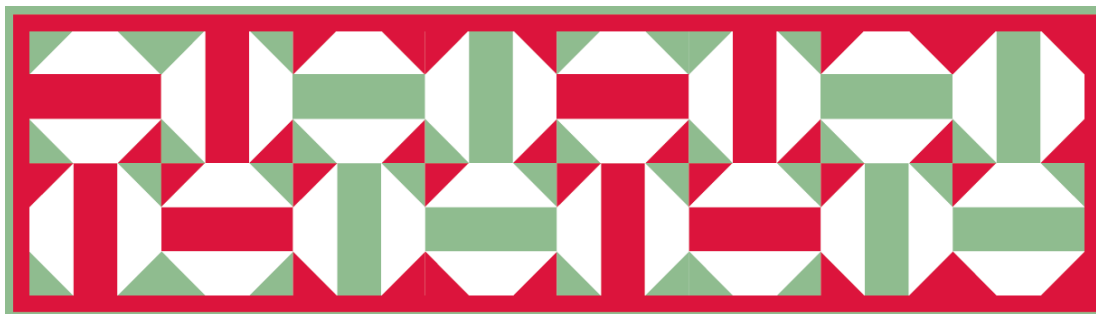

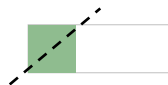

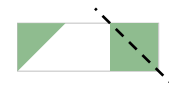
### Snowball Corners Tutorial

To make Snowball Corners you'll see in my instructions to cut some larger strips and some smaller squares. The smaller squares will say, "On the back side of the square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time." When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for Snowball Corners, gather up the larger strips and the smaller squares associated with it.

With right sides together, line up the smaller square so that it is perfectly even with the corner and sides of the larger strip. Then



sew **ON** the line that you drew (the black dashed line in the image on the left). Repeat the same process for the remaining corner (image on the right shows how to repeat the same process on the opposite corner than the one in the image on the right).

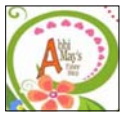

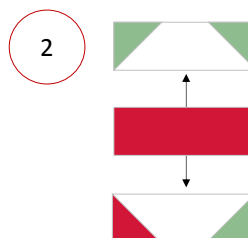
**Sewing the “Ornament’s Quilt Blocks” Together**

(Doesn’t matter which colored quilt block you’re making they’re all sewn together the same way.)



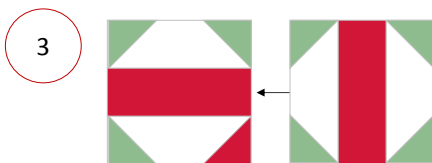

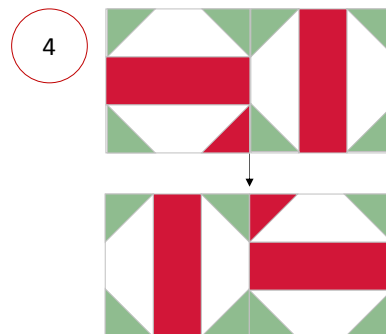

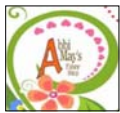
Make TWO (2) with the

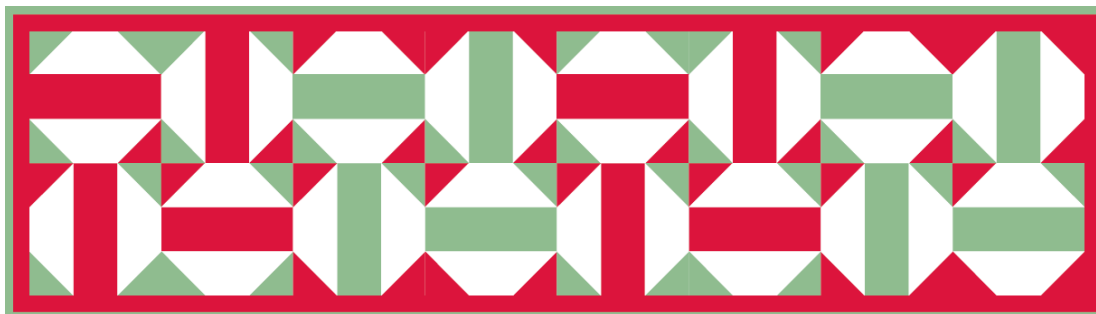

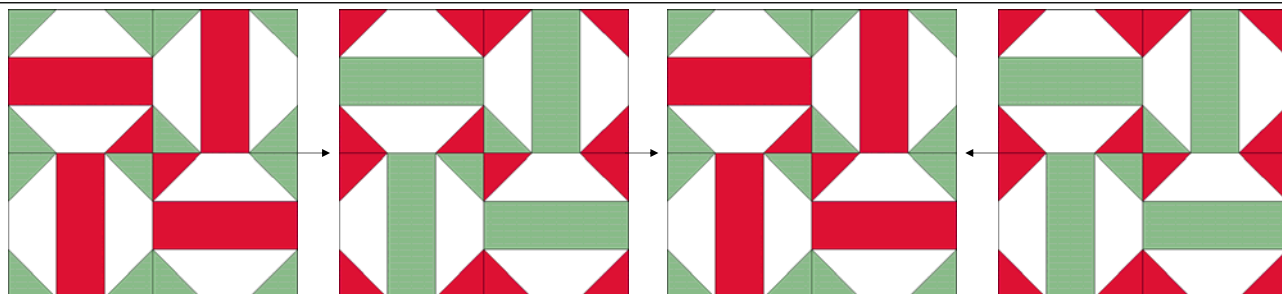

### Cutting Requirements for Finishing "Ornament's Table Runner"

|       |   |
|-------|---|
| Red   | Cut TWO (2) 3/4" x 8 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border)  |
| Red   | Cut TWO (2) 3/4" x 33 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border) |
| Green | Cut & piece THREE (3) 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)       |

### Sewing the "Ornament's Table Runner" Together



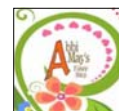
There's nothing difficult about this step in the process. Just be sure to press in the direction of the arrows.

Finished Size = 9" x 33"

Once you've sewn the "Ornament's Table Runner" together then add the border.  
Quilt as desired then sew on your binding!
