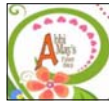

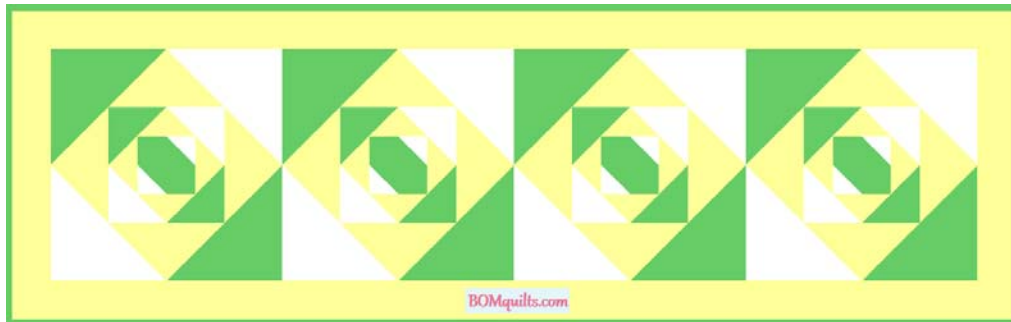

## "Christmas Pineapple Table Runner"

Finished Table Runner Size = 12 1/4" x 39 1/4"

Finished Block Size = 10" square | Unfinished Block Size = 10 1/2" Square

This is the perfect quilt project for a confident beginner! If you can make a Square in a Square you can make this table runner! And If chain stitch it you'll find that it'll sew together in no time flat!

### Fabric Requirements for the "Ornaments Table Runner" shown above (including Binding)

Green	1/2 yard (includes Binding)
Yellow	1/2 yard (includes Border)
White	1/2 yard

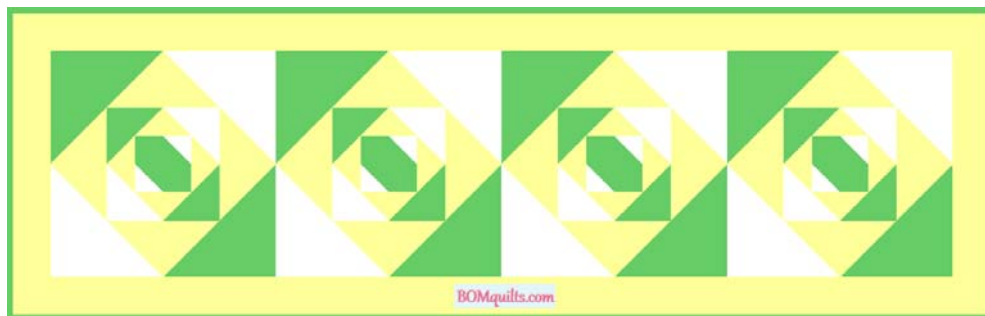

**All Cuts Needed for the "Road to Grandma's House" Quilt Blocks**

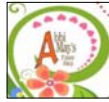
Color	Cuts
Yellow	Cut FOUR (4) 3 3/4" squares. Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles.
Yellow	Cut EIGHT (8) 6 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square.
Green	Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/2" squares.
Green	Cut FOUR (4) 3 3/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
Green	Cut FOUR (4) 5 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut EIGHT (8) 2" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut FOUR (4) 3 3/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut FOUR (4) 5 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.

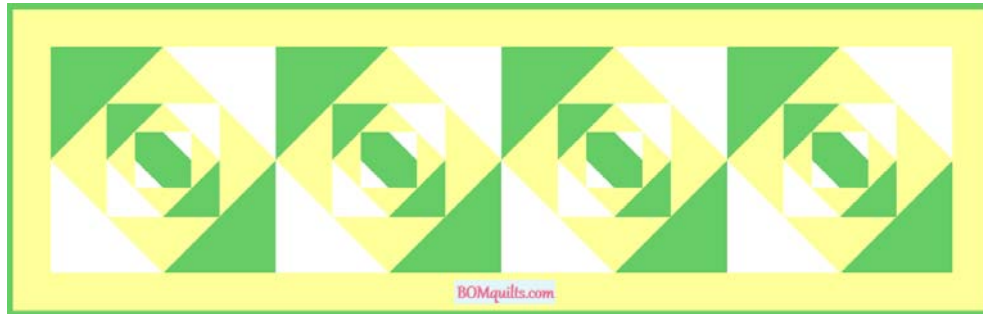

### Sewing the "Pineapple Christmas" Quilt Blocks Together

#### Square in a Square Tutorial

You'll see in my "Cutting Instructions" to cut some squares ONE (1) time, or TWO (2) times diagonally, corner-to-corner. In the case of the "Pineapple Christmas" quilt blocks, the center square has TWO (2) Snowball Corners sewed to each of the center blocks. When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for a Square in a Square follow the diagram (Figure #1) first.

Then follow the diagram (Figure #2) second.

Press in the direction of the arrows. You need to make a total of SIXTEEN (16) different Square in a Square portions for the FOUR (4) "Pineapple Christmas" quilt blocks.

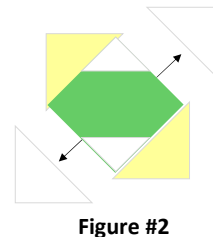

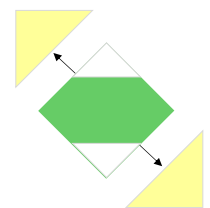

#### Snowball Corners Tutorial

You'll see in my instructions to cut some squares smaller and some larger. The smaller squares will say, "On the back side of the square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time." When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for Snowball Corners, gather up the larger square and the TWO (2) smaller squares associated with it.

With right sides together, line up the smaller square so that it is perfectly even with the corner and sides of the larger square. Then sew ON the line that you drew (Figure #1, it's the red dashed line).

Repeat the same process for the remaining corner (Figure #2 on the right shows how to repeat the same process on the opposite corner).

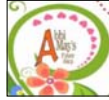

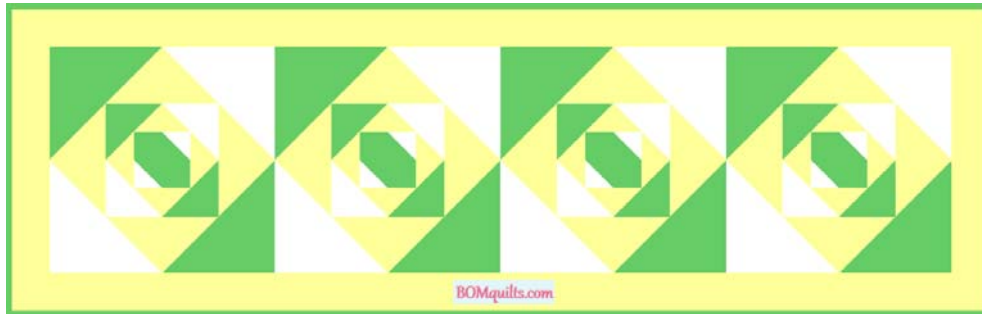

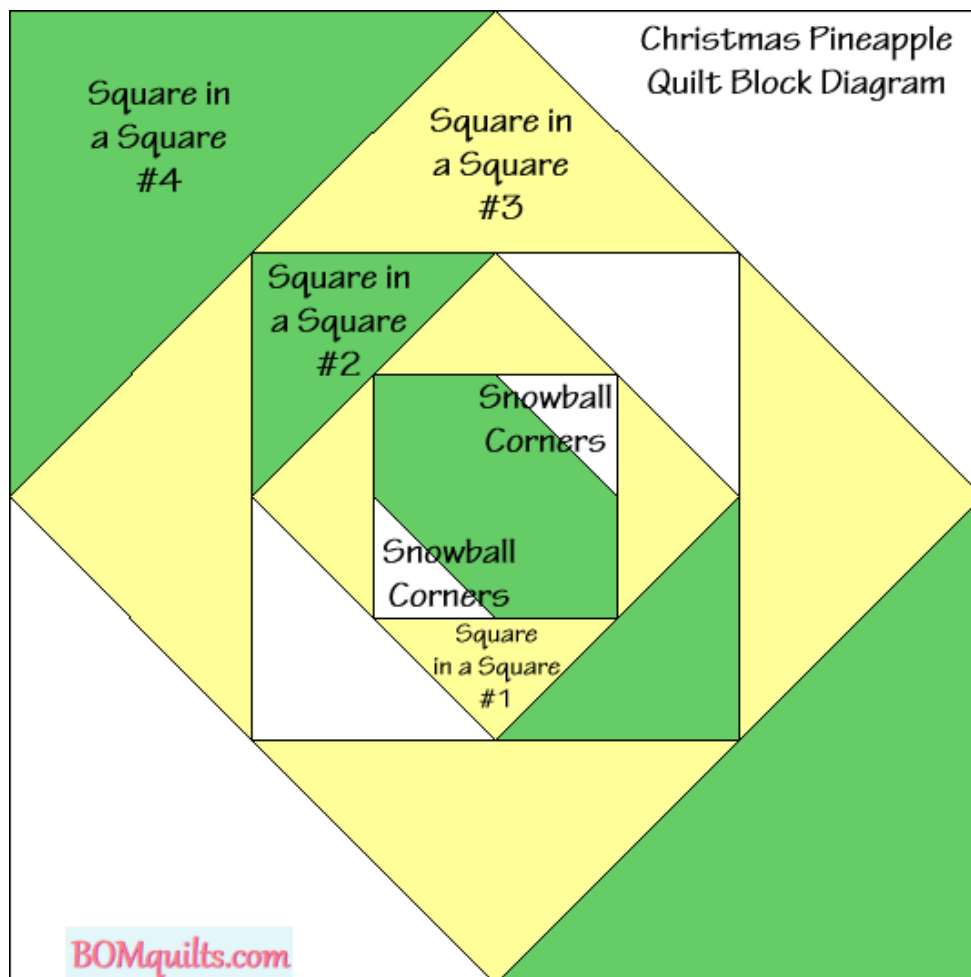

### "Christmas Pineapple" Quilt Block Diagram

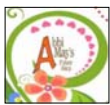

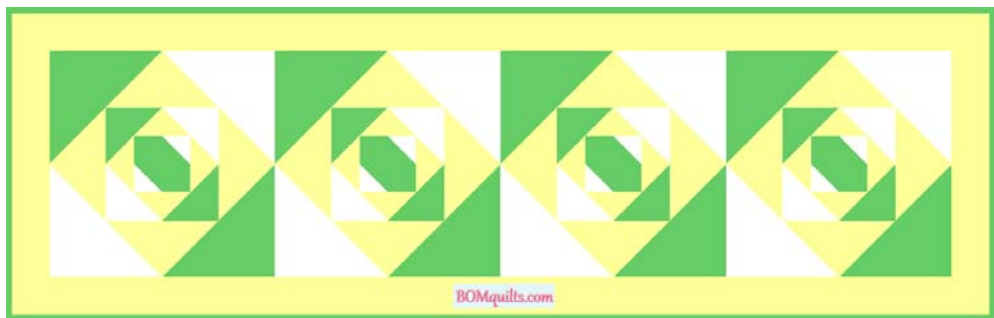

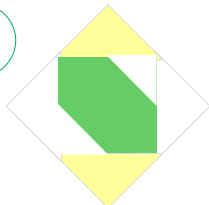
**“Christmas Pineapple”

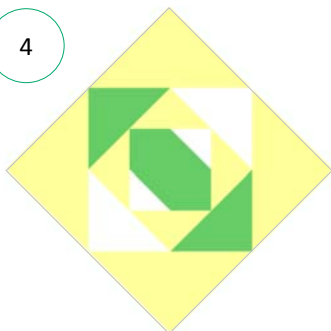

**Sewing the “Christmas Pineapple” Table Runner Together**



There’s nothing difficult about this step in the process. Sew your FOUR (4) “Christmas Pineapple” quilt blocks together as shown above. And press in the direction of the arrows.

**Final Fabric Cuts for the “Christmas Pineapple Table Runner”**

Yellow	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2” x 40 1/2” strips (Top & Bottom Border)
Yellow	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2” x 13 1/2” strips (Left & Right Border)
Green	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3/4” x WOF strips (Binding)

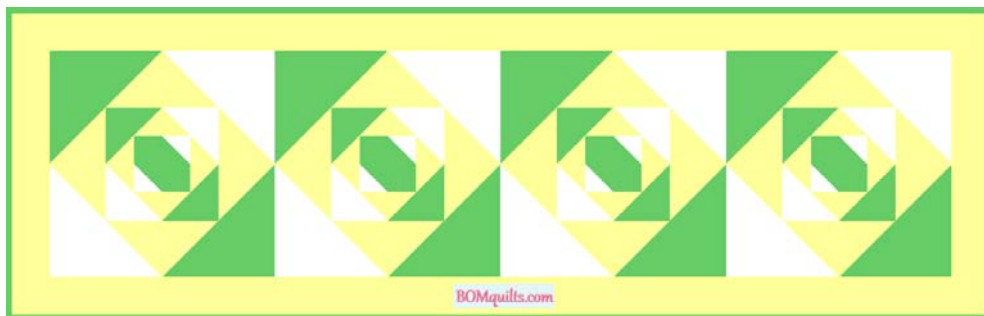

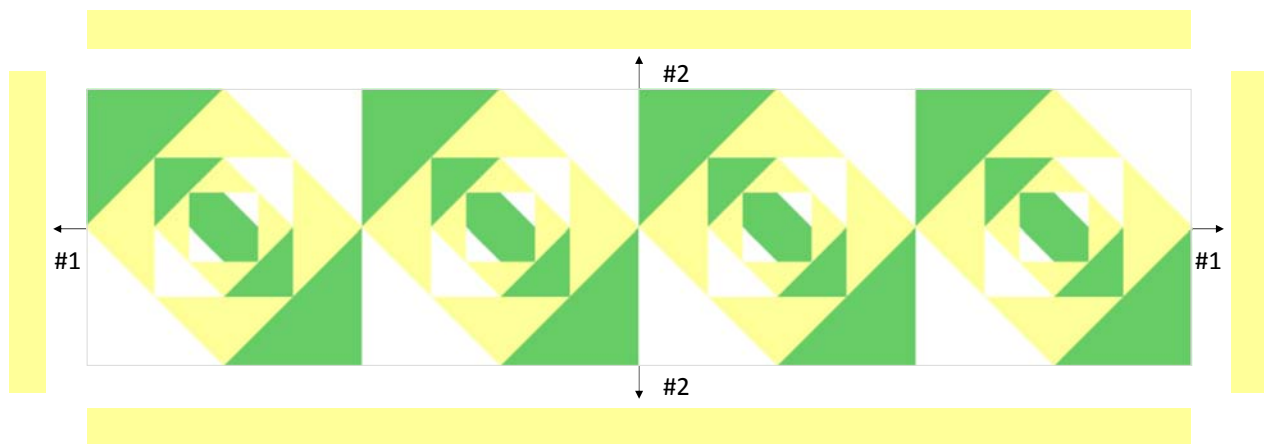

### Finishing the "Christmas Pineapple Table Runner"

First sew on the Left & Right Borders (labeled #1 below). Then sew on the Top & Bottom Borders (labeled #2 below).



Once you've sewn the "Christmas Pineapple Table Runner" together, then quilt as desire & sew on the binding!
