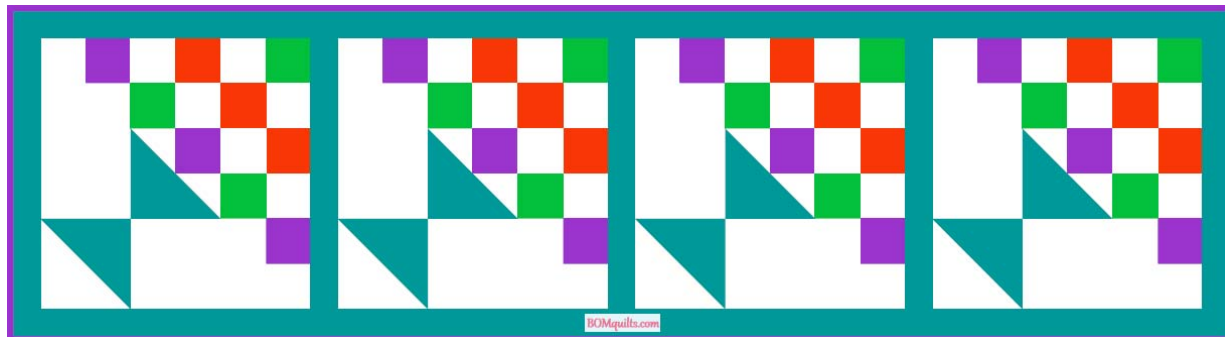

"Fruit Basket Table Runner"

Finished Table Runner Size = 12 1/4" x 45 1/4"

Finished Block Size = 10" square | Unfinished Block Size = 10 1/2" Square

This isn't your aunt's fruit cake!

This is the perfect quilt project for a confident beginner! If you can make a few Half-Square Triangles you can make this table runner! And if chain stitch it you'll find that it'll sew together in no time flat!

Fabric Requirements for the "Fruit Basket Table Runner" shown above (including Binding)

Green	1/8 yard
Red	1/8 yard
Purple	1/4 yard (includes Binding)
Teal	1/2 yard (includes Border)
White	1/2 yard

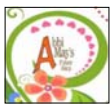

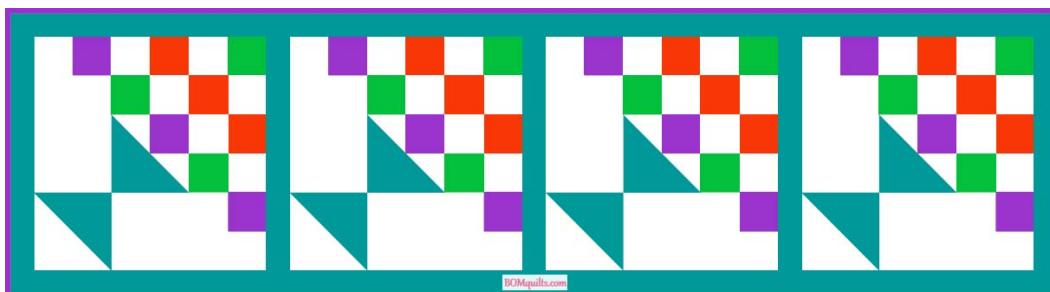

All Cuts Needed for the "Fruit Basket" Quilt Blocks

Color	Cuts
Green	Cut TWELVE (12) 2 1/8" squares.
Red	Cut TWELVE (12) 2 1/8" squares.
Purple	Cut TWELVE (12) 2 1/8" squares.
Teal	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/8" squares.
White	Cut TWELVE (12) 2 1/2" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut EIGHT (8) 3 7/8" squares.
White	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/8" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.

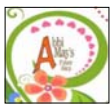
Ed. Note: The colors of the "Fruit" aren't set in stone. You can use any fabric colors you'd like to use! Or better said, you can have any kind of "Fruit" in your "Basket," that you'd like to have!

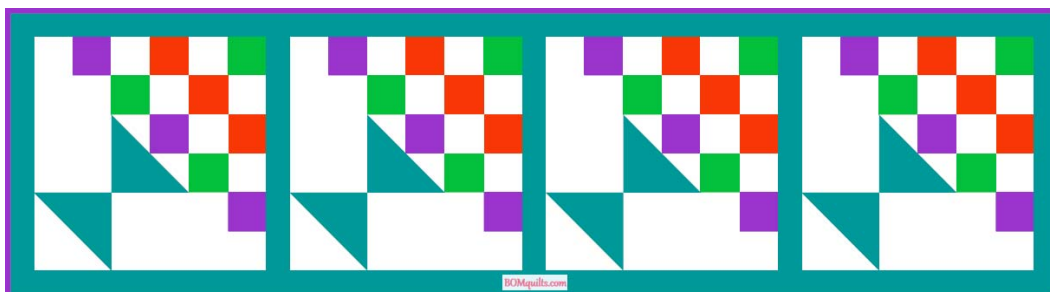

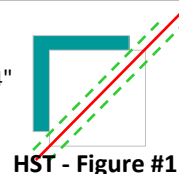

Sewing the "Fruit Basket" Quilt Blocks Together

Half-Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial

Place the White 4 1/8" square on the Teal 4 1/8" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (shown in green in Figure #1). Then cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew (shown in red in Figure #1).



Red line = Drawn line

Green dashed line = Sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the drawn line

HST - Figure #1

You'll end up with TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric.



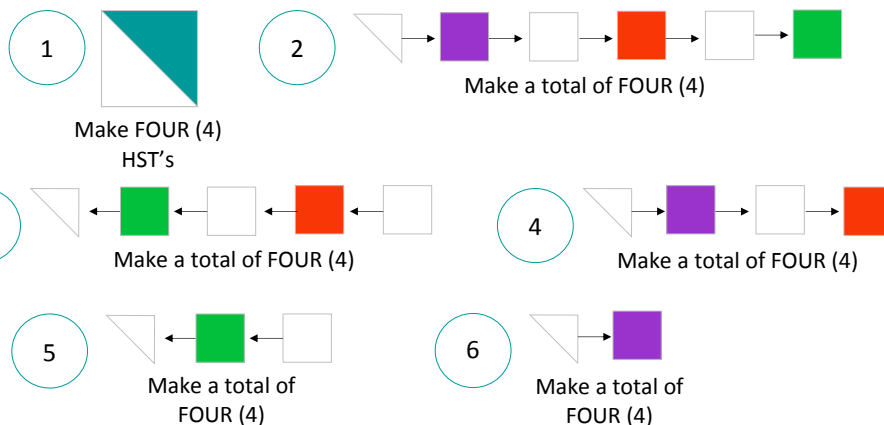

Quilt Note: When making HST's, try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to 3 1/2" square. You need to make a total of FOUR (4) for all FOUR (4) "Fruit Basket" quilt blocks.

Sewing the "Fruit Basket" Table Runner Together



Sew the Sashing between the "Fruit Basket" quilt blocks as shown above. Then sew them into the "Fruit Basket Table Runner."
Press in the direction of the arrows.

Final Fabric Cuts for the "Fruit Basket Table Runner"

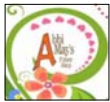
Teal	Cut & piece TWO (2) 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border)
Teal	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border)
Purple	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3/4" x WOF strips (Binding)

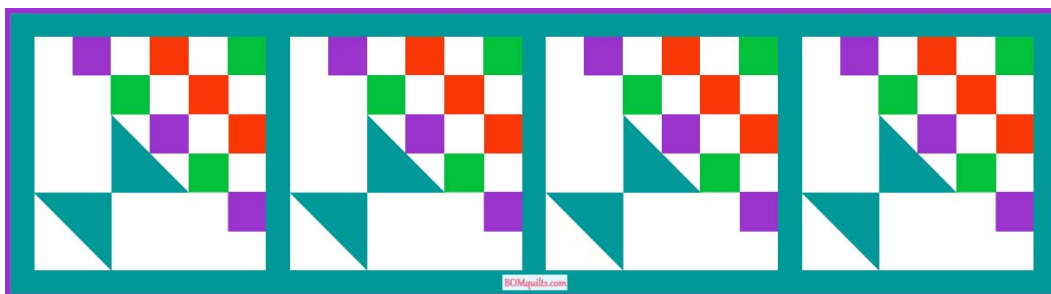

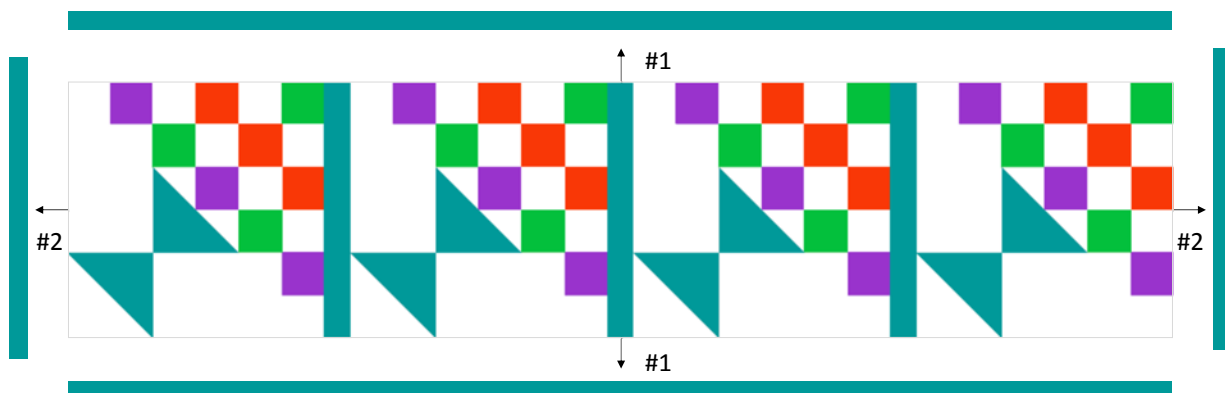

Finishing the "Fruit Basket Table Runner"

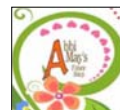
First sew on the Top & Bottom Borders (labeled #1 below). Then sew on the Left & Right Borders (labeled #2 below).



Once you've sewn the "Fruit Basket Table Runner" together, then quilt as desire & sew on the binding!
