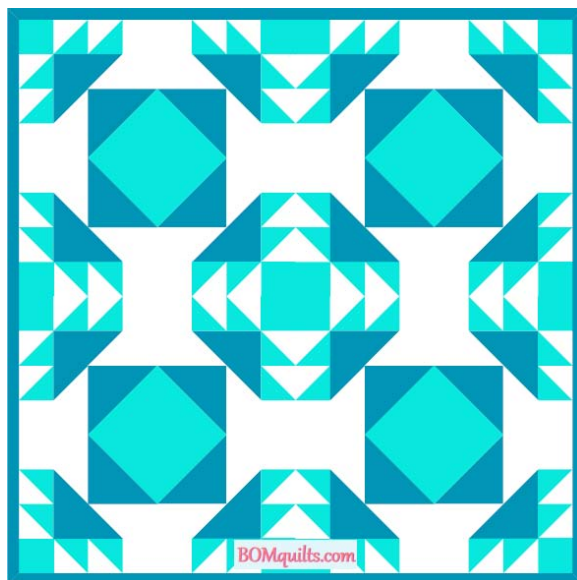
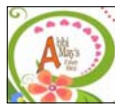

"Christmas Jewel Table Topper"

Finished Table Topper Size = 24" Square

Finished Block Size = 12" square | Unfinished Block Size = 12 1/2" Square

This is the perfect quilt project for a confident beginner! If you can make a Square in a Square & Half-Square Triangles then you can make this table topper! And If chain stitch it you'll find that it'll sew together in no time flat!

Fabric Requirements for the "Christmas Jewel Table Topper" shown above (including Binding)

Aqua	1/2 yard
Teal	1/2 yard (includes Border)
White	3/8 yard

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

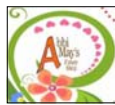
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All Cuts Needed for all FOUR (4) of the "Christmas Jewel" Quilt Blocks

Color	Cuts
Aqua	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2" squares.
Aqua	Cut THIRTY-TWO (32) 2 3/8" squares.
Aqua	Cut FOUR (4) 4 3/4" squares.
Teal	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3 3/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut THIRTY-TWO (32) 2 3/8" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3 3/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut FOUR (4) 7 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square.

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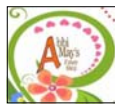
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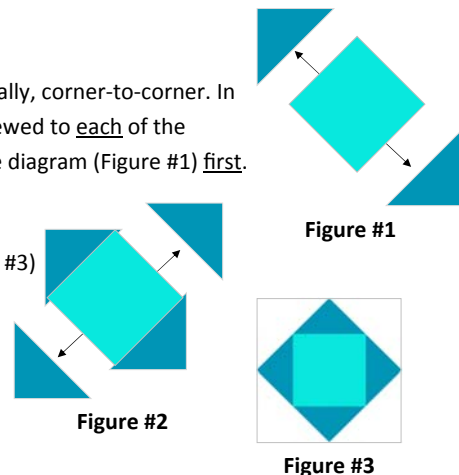
Sewing the "Christmas Jewel" Quilt Blocks Together

Square in a Square Tutorial

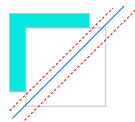
You'll see in my "Cutting Instructions" to cut some squares ONE (1) time, or TWO (2) times diagonally, corner-to-corner. In the case of the "Christmas Jewel" quilt blocks, the center square has TWO (2) Snowball Corners sewed to each of the center blocks. When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for a Square in a Square follow the diagram (Figure #1) first.

Then follow the diagram (Figure #2) second. Then you'll make another Square in a Square (Figure #3) for this "Christmas Jewel" quilt block.

Press in the direction of the arrows. You need to make a total of TWELVE (12) different Square in a Squares for the FOUR (4) "Christmas Jewel" quilt blocks.



Half-Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial

Place the White $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square on the Aqua $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square (right sides together) and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (Figure #1). Then cut the Half-Square Triangles (HST's) apart ON the line you drew. You'll end up with TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).



Quilt Note: When making Half Square Triangles, try cutting your squares $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{2}$ " larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block. You need a total of SIXTEEN (16) of these HST's for ONE (1) "Christmas Jewel" Quilt Block! That's a total of SIXTY-FOUR (64) for all FOUR (4) "Christmas Jewel" Quilt Blocks.

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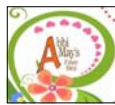
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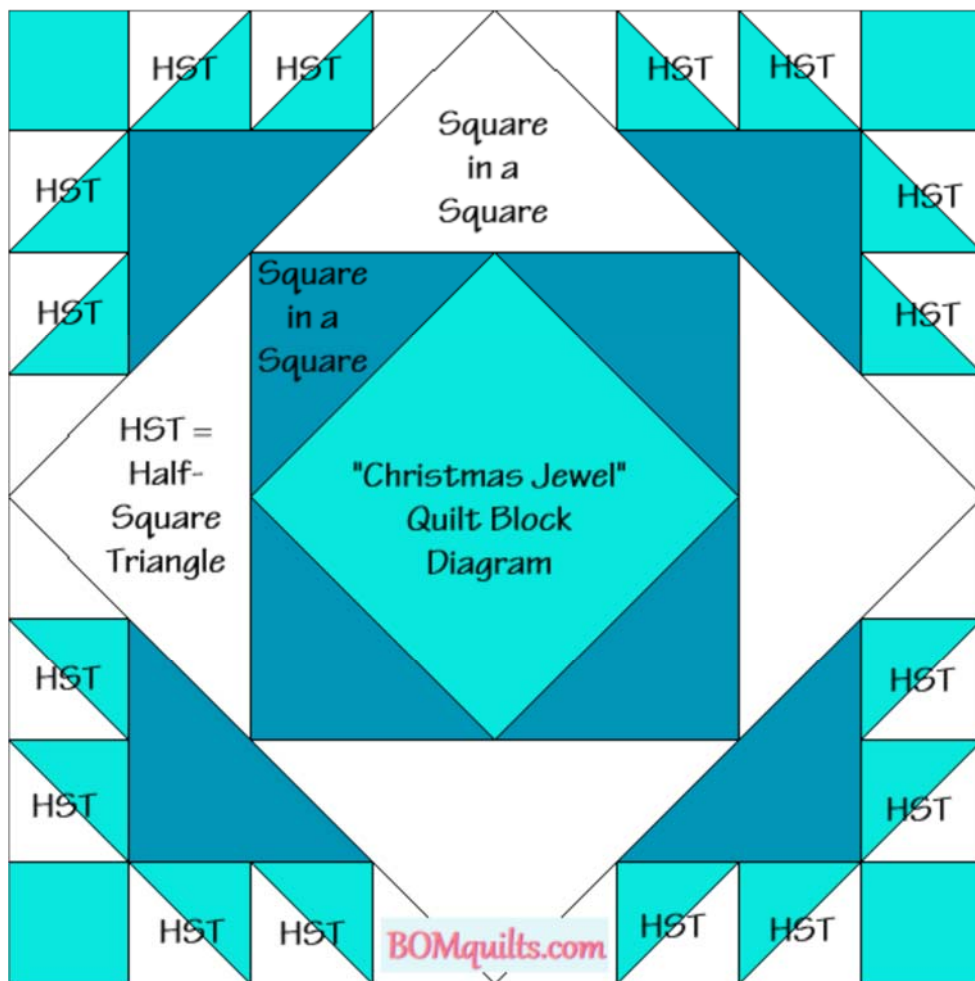
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"Christmas Jewel" Quilt Block Diagram



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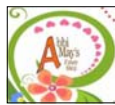

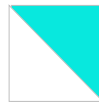

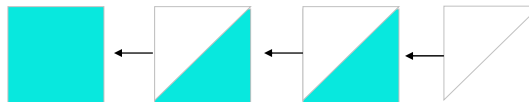
Create THREE (3) Square in a Squares for each of the FOUR (4) center's of the quilt blocks.

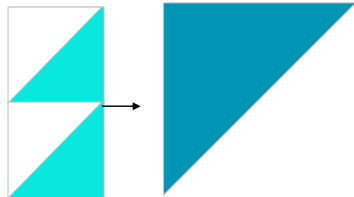
Then create SIXTEEN (16) Half-Square Triangles for each of the FOUR (4) blocks.

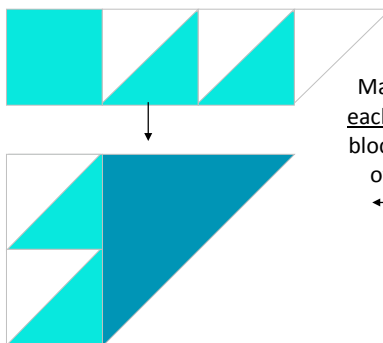
Then create FOUR (4) for each of the FOUR (4) blocks.

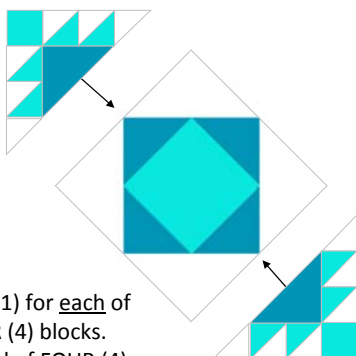
Make FOUR (4) for each of the FOUR (4) blocks. That's a total of SIXTEEN (16).

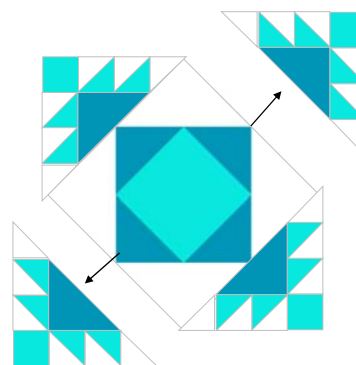
Make FOUR (4) for each of the FOUR (4) blocks. That's a total of SIXTEEN (16).

Make ONE (1) for each of the FOUR (4) blocks. That's a total of FOUR (4).

Make ONE (1) for each of the FOUR (4) blocks. That's a total of FOUR (4).

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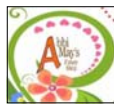
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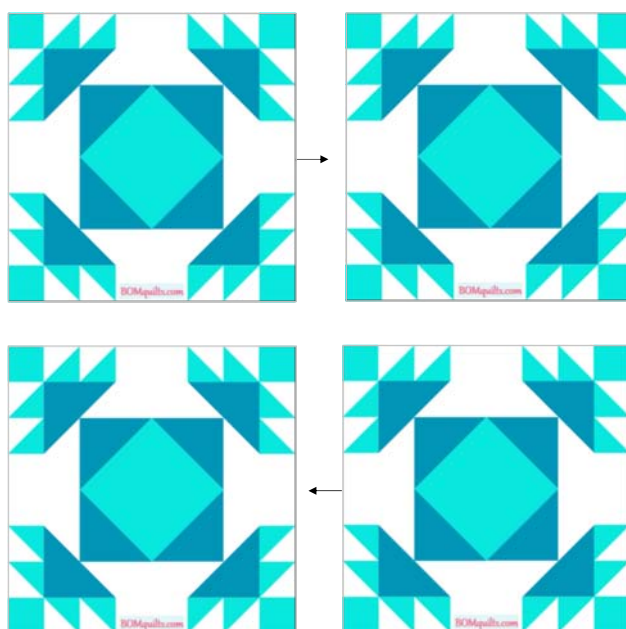

Sewing the "Christmas Jewel" Table Topper Together

There's nothing difficult about this step in the process. Sew your FOUR (4) "Christmas Jewel" quilt blocks together as shown below. Then press in the direction of the arrows.



Final Fabric Cuts for the "Christmas Jewel Table Topper"

Teal

Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)

Once you've sewn the "Christmas Jewel" Table Topper together, then quilt as desire & sew on the binding!
