

Finished Block Size = 15" square | Unfinished Block Size = 15 1/2" Square

If you're able to make a large number of Quarter-Square Triangles then you can make this quilt! Plus If you chain stitch it you'll find that it'll sew together with ease!

| Fabric Requirements for the "Crowning Glory Christmas Quilt" shown above (including Binding) | |
|--|---------------------------------|
| Green | 1 yard (Includes Binding) |
| Yellow | 2 5/8 yard (Includes Border #1) |
| Red | 4 yards (includes Border #2) |
| White | 1 1/4 yards |



<u>All</u> Cuts Needed for all TEN (10) of the "Crowning Glory Christmas #1" Quilt Blocks



| | Green | Cut TEN (10) 5 1/2" squares. |
| | Red | Cut FORTY (40) 3" squares. |
| | Red | Cut TEN (10) 6 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square. |
| | Yellow | Cut FORTY (4) 3 5/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| | Yellow | Cut TEN (10) 6 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square. |
| | White | Cut TWENTY (20) 5 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. |

"Crowning Glory Christmas #2" Quilt Block Make TEN (10)

All Cuts Needed for all TEN (10) of the "Crowning Glory Christmas #2" Quilt Blocks Color Cuts Cut TEN (10) 5 1/2" squares. Green Cut FORTY (40) 3" squares. Yellow Yellow Cut TEN (10) 6 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square. Red Cut FORTY (4) 3 5/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. Cut TEN (10) 6 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) Red times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square. White Cut TWENTY (20) 5 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.



Quarter-Square Triangle (QST) Tutorial

You'll see on my instructions to either cut some quilt squares ONE (1) time or TWO (2) times. Both of them diagonally, corner-to-corner. When piecing a QST, follow <u>Figure #1</u> first & then follow <u>Figure #2</u> to finish your QST! <u>Figure #3</u> shows a finished QST! Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears). These are the TWO (2) different Quarter-Square Triangles need for the "Morning Star" quilt blocks & the "Morning Star Variation" quilt blocks (below):

| Final Fabric Cuts for the "Crowning Glory Christmas Quilt" | | |
|--|--|--|
| Yellow | Cut & piece 2 1/2" x 83 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border #1) | |
| Yellow | Cut & piece 2 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border #1) | |
| Red | Cut & piece 4" x 87 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border #2) | |
| Red | Cut & piece 4" x 77 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border #2) | |
| Green | Cut & piece SEVEN (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding) | |

Sew the Yellow Borders #1 to the newly created quilt top (follow the numbers). Press in the direction of the arrows.






Sewing the "Crowning Glory Christmas Quilt" Together (cont.)

Then press in the direction of the arrows.



Once you've sewn the "Christmas Morning Stars Quilt" together, then quilt as desire & sew on the binding!
