

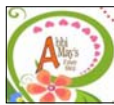

"The King's Crown Table Runner"

Finished Table Runner Size = 15" x 52"

Finished Block Size = 12" square | Unfinished Block Size = 12 1/2" Square

While there are some Square in a Squares, Flying Geese & a lot of Half-Square Triangles in this table runner.

It shouldn't be a bother for almost anyone to sew together!

And If chain stitch it you'll find that it'll sew together in no time flat!

Fabric Requirements for the "The King's Crown Table Runner" shown above (including Binding)

Purple	3/8 yard (includes Binding)
Aqua	1/2 yard (includes Border)
White	1/2 yard

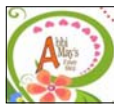

All Cuts Needed for the "The King's Crown" Quilt Blocks

Color	Cuts
Purple	Cut FOUR (4) 3 3/4 " squares.
Aqua	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 7/8 squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
Aqua	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 7/8" squares.
White	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 1/2" squares.
White	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 7/8" squares. On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut TWELVE (12) 4 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
White	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/4" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles per square.

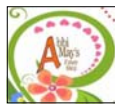

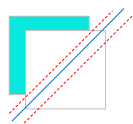
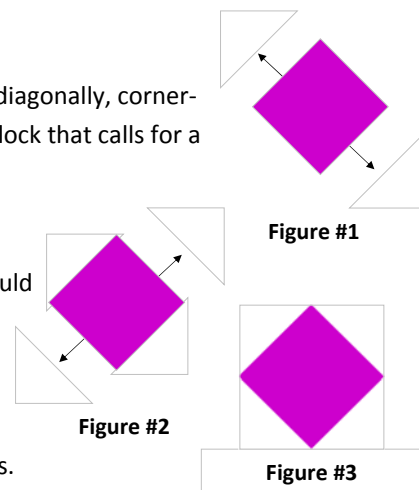
Sewing the "The King's Crown" Quilt Blocks Together

Square in a Square Tutorial

You'll see in my "Cutting Instructions" to cut some squares ONE (1) time, or TWO (2) times diagonally, corner-o-corner. In the case of "The King's Crown" quilt blocks. When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for a Square in a Square follow the diagram (Figure #1) first.

Then follow the diagram (Figure #2) second. When the Square in a Square is finished it should look like the (Figure #3) for this "Christmas Jewel" quilt block.

Press in the direction of the arrows. You need to make a total of **FOUR (4)** Square in a Squares: That's ONE (1) for each of the FOUR (4) "The King's Crown" quilt blocks.

Half-Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial



HST Figure #2

Place the White $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square on the Aqua $2\frac{3}{8}$ " square (right sides together) and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (Figure #1). Then cut the Half-Square Triangles (HST's) apart ON the line you drew. You'll end up with TWO (2) Half-Square Triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).



Quilt Note: When making Half Square Triangles, try cutting your squares $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{2}$ " larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block. You need a **total of EIGHT (8)** of these HST's for ONE (1) "The King's Crown" Quilt Block! That's a total of **THIRTY-TWO (32)** for all FOUR (4) of the "The King's Crown" Quilt Blocks.

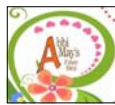

Flying Geese Tutorial

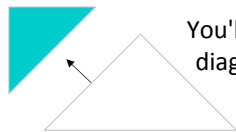

You'll see in my instructions to either cut some squares ONE (1) time or TWO (2) times. Both of them diagonally, corner-to-corner. When piecing a Flying Geese for a quilt block, follow the diagram on the left first (adding a smaller Aqua triangle to the larger White triangle) & then follow the diagram on the right (adding the second smaller Aqua triangle to the newly created Aqua/White triangles).

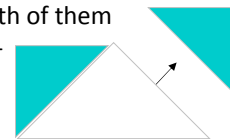


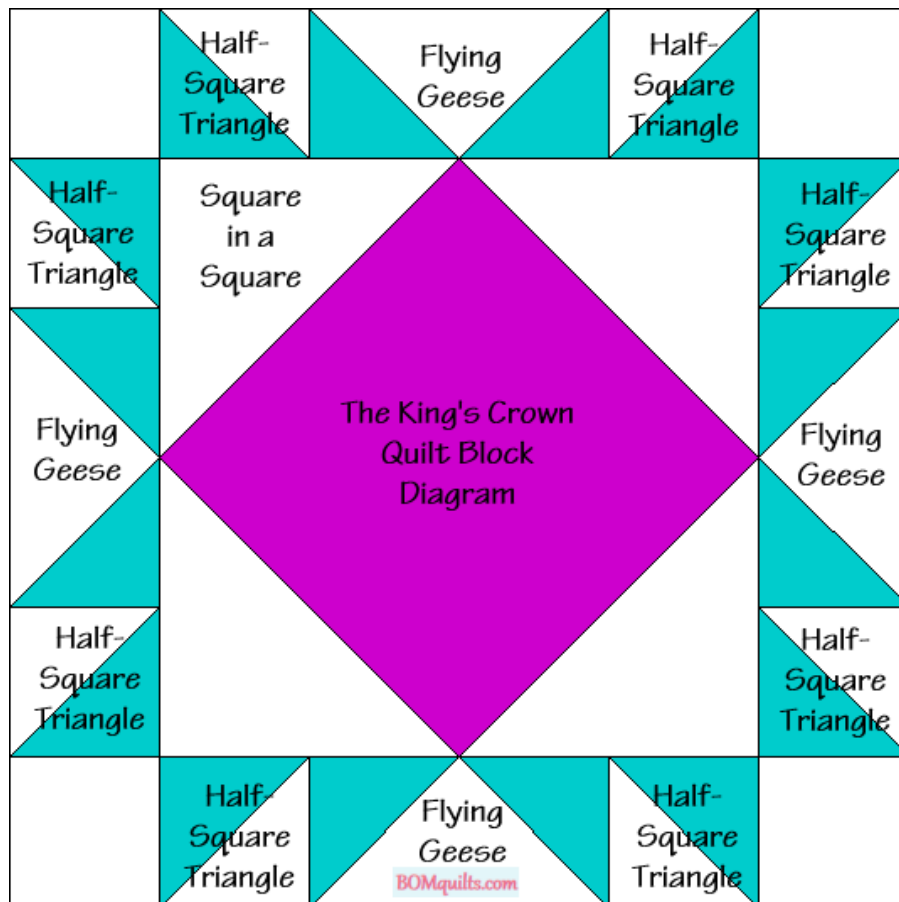

You need to make a total of **SIXTEEN (16)** Flying Geese for "The King's Crown" Table Runner.



Quilt Note: If you're making a quilt block, that has a lot of Flying Geese in it, sometimes it's best if you press all of your Flying Geese seams open.

Sewing the "The King's Crown Table Runner" Together



There's nothing difficult about this step in the process. Sew your FOUR (4) "The King's Crown" quilt blocks together as shown above. Then press in the direction of the arrows.

Final Fabric Cuts for the "The King's Crown Table Runner"

Aqua	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border)
Aqua	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2" x 15 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border)
Purple	Cut & piece FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

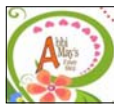

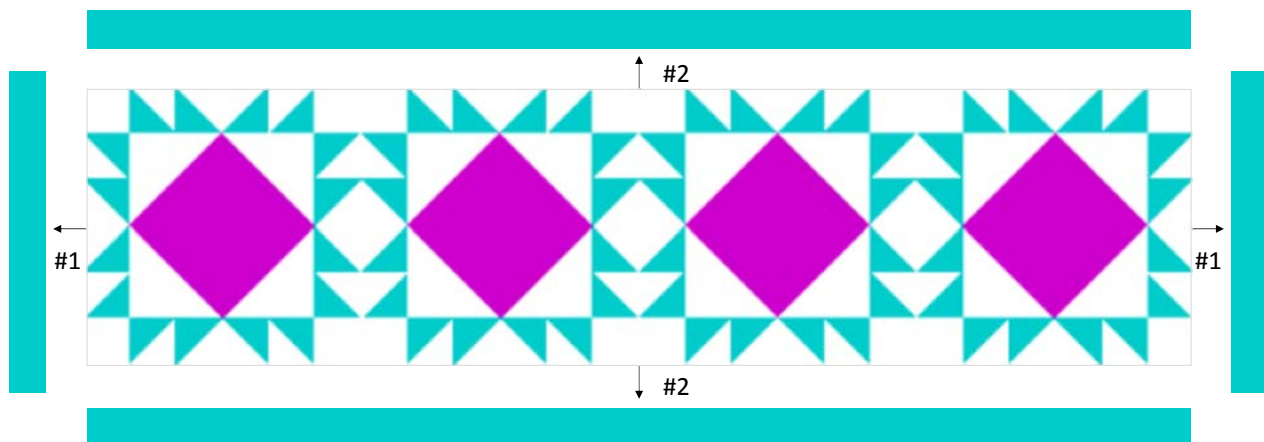

Finishing "The King's Crown Table Runner"

First sew on the Left & Right Borders (labeled #1 below). Then sew on the Top & Bottom Borders (labeled #2 below).



Once you've sewn the "The King's Crown Table Runner" together, then quilt as desired & sew on the binding!
