

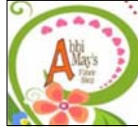

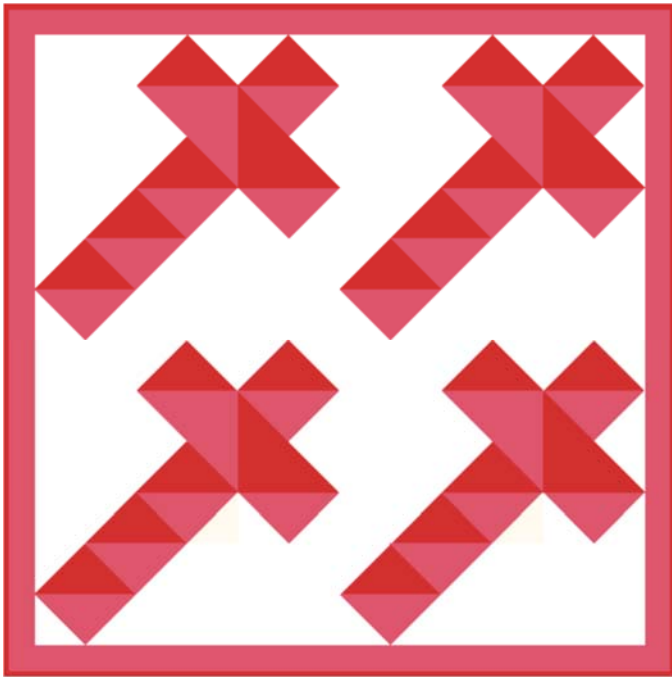
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The "Cross" is a traditionally pieced Table
Topper & so much more! It just depends on how many
"Cross" quilt blocks you want to make which will de-
termine what you create!

Finished Table Topper = 26" Square

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 12" Square

Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 12 1/2" Square

Purchase the Quilt Kit from:

All seams a scant 1/4"

Press in the direction of the arrows

Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning

There's only ONE (1) quilt block that makes up the "Cross" Table Topper!

Fabric Requirements

|-------|-----------------------------|
| Pink | 1/2 yard (Includes Binding) |
| Red | 3/8 yard (Includes Border) |
| White | 3/4 yard |

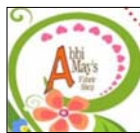


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Cutting Requirements for ONE (1) "Cross" Quilt Block

| Fabric Color | First Cut | Second Cut |
|--------------|-------------------------------|--|
| Red | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles. |
| Red | Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares. | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. You only need THREE (3) of these triangles for this quilt block. Save it for the second "Cross" quilt block. |
| Red | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | N/A |
| Pink | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles. You only need ONE (1) of these triangles for this quilt block. Save it for the second "Cross" quilt block. |
| Pink | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles. |
| Pink | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You'll end up with FOUR (4) triangles. |
| Pink | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | N/A |
| White | Cut THREE (3) 2 7/8" squares. | Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| White | Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/8" squares. | On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. |
| White | Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles. |

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.

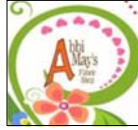
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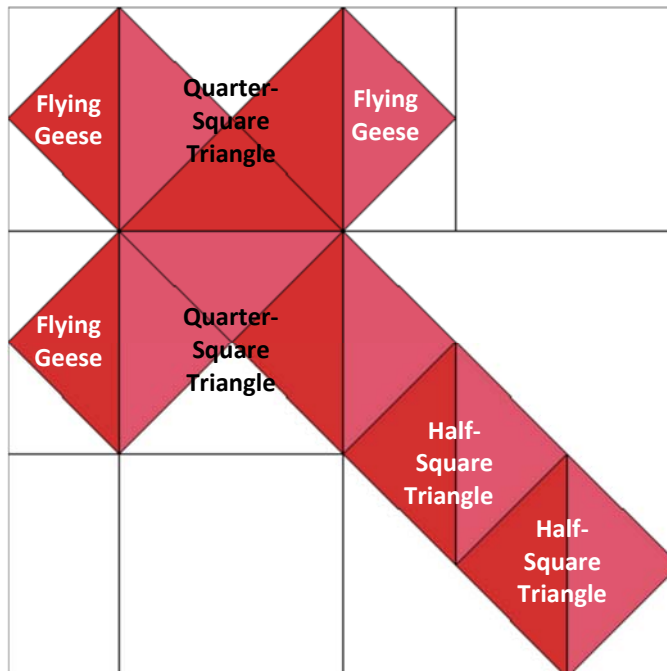
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| Fabric Color | First Cut | Second Cut |
|--------------|--|--|
| White | Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares. | N/A |
| White | Cut ONE (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle. | N/A |
| White | Cut ONE (1) 4 7/8" square | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles. You only need ONE (1) of these triangles for this quilt block. Save it for the second "Cross" quilt block. |
| White | Cut ONE (1) 6 7/8" square. | Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles. You only need ONE (1) of these triangles for this quilt block. Save it for the second "Cross" quilt block. |

"Cross" Quilt Block Diagram



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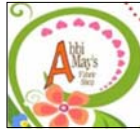


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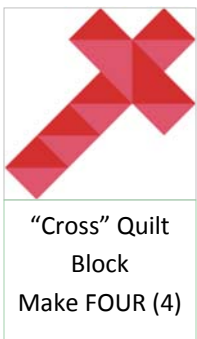

Fabric Cuts for Finishing the "Cross" Table Topper

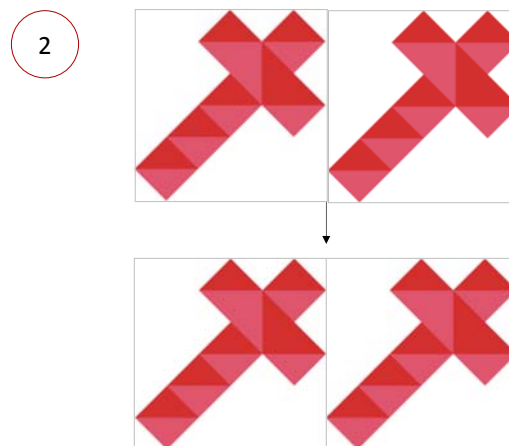
| | |
|------|--|
| Pink | Cut TWO (2) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strips. (Left & Right Border) |
| Pink | Cut TWO (2) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips. (Top & Bottom Border) |
| Red | Cut & piece THREE (3) 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding) |

Finishing Instructions:

- 1) Sew the newly created "Cross" quilt blocks together.
- 2) Sew the newly created TWO (2) rows to each other.
- 3) Sew the Left & Right Borders to the newly created "Cross" Table Topper.
- 4) Sew the Top & Bottom Borders to the newly created "Cross" Table Topper.
- 5) Quilt as desired & then sew on your binding!

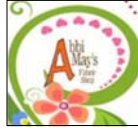


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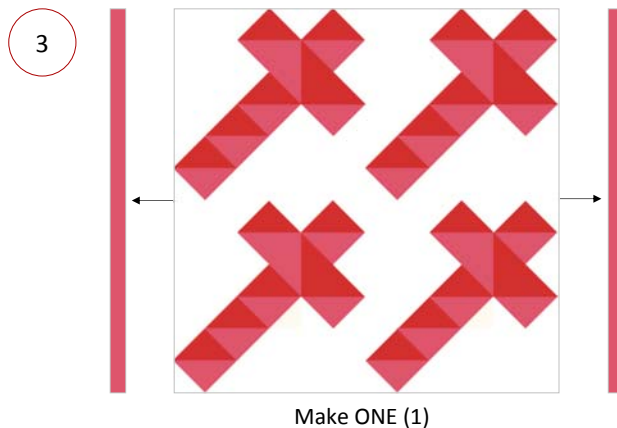
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Finishing Instructions:

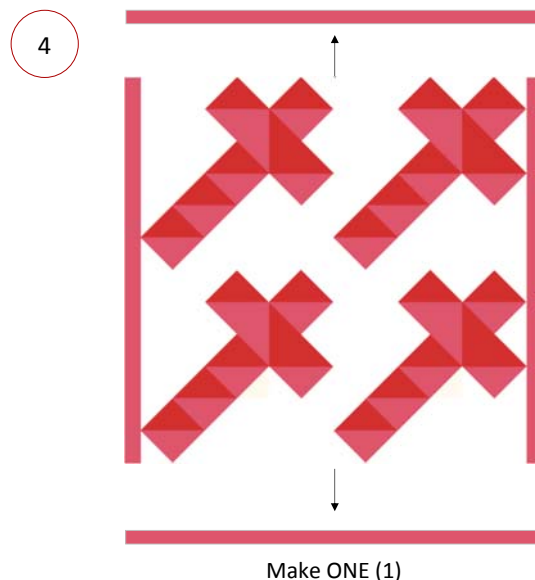
- 1) Sew the newly created "Cross" quilt blocks together.
- 2) Sew the newly created TWO (2) rows to each other.
- 3) Sew the Left & Right Borders to the newly created "Cross" Table Topper.
- 4) Sew the Top & Bottom Borders to the newly created "Cross" Table Topper.
- 5) Quilt as desired & then sew on your binding!



There are never enough "Cross" quilt blocks!

This pattern explains how to make ONE (1) single "Cross" quilt block & ONE (1) "Cross" Table Topper.

With this pattern it's possible to make a "Cross" Table Runner, a Long Table Runner, a Lap Quilt or a Quilt. Just decrease or increase the number of "Cross" quilt blocks to reach the desired size of the finished project!



Congrats!

Now that the "Cross" Table Topper is sewn together, it's time to quilt as desired & then sew on the binding!
