

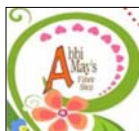

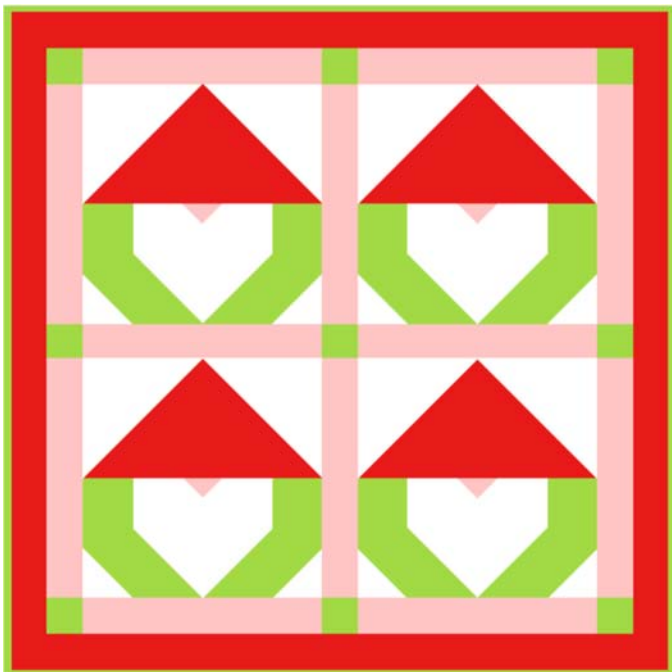

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 10" Square

Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 10 1/2" Square

All seams a scant 1/4"

Press in the direction of the arrows

Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning

There's only ONE (1) quilt block that makes up the "Santa Gnome" Table Topper!

Pink	1/4 yard
Red	1/2 yard (Includes Border)
Green	3/8 yard (Includes Binding)
White	1/2 yard

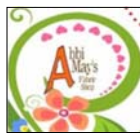

Cutting Requirements for ONE (1) “Santa Gnome” Quilt Block

Fabric Color	First Cut	Second Cut
Red	Cut ONE (1) 10 1/2” square.	Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You’ll end up with TWO (2) triangles.
Pink	Cut TWO (2) 1 5/8” squares.	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
Green	Cut ONE (1) 3 3/4” square.	N/A
Green	Cut TWO (2) 2 5/8” x 5 7/8” rectangles	N/A
White	Cut TWO (2) 2 5/8” squares.	N/A
White	Cut ONE (1) 2 7/8” square.	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut ONE (1) 3 3/4” square.	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut ONE (1) 5 7/8” square.	Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You’ll end up with TWO (2) triangles.
White	Cut TWO (2) 1 3/8” x 2 7/8” rectangles.	N/A

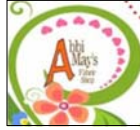

Sewing ONE (1) "Santa Gnome" Quilt Block Together! Make FOUR (4) for the "Santa Gnome" Table Topper!



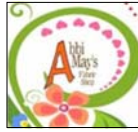

Finishing Instructions for the “Santa Gnome” Table Topper!



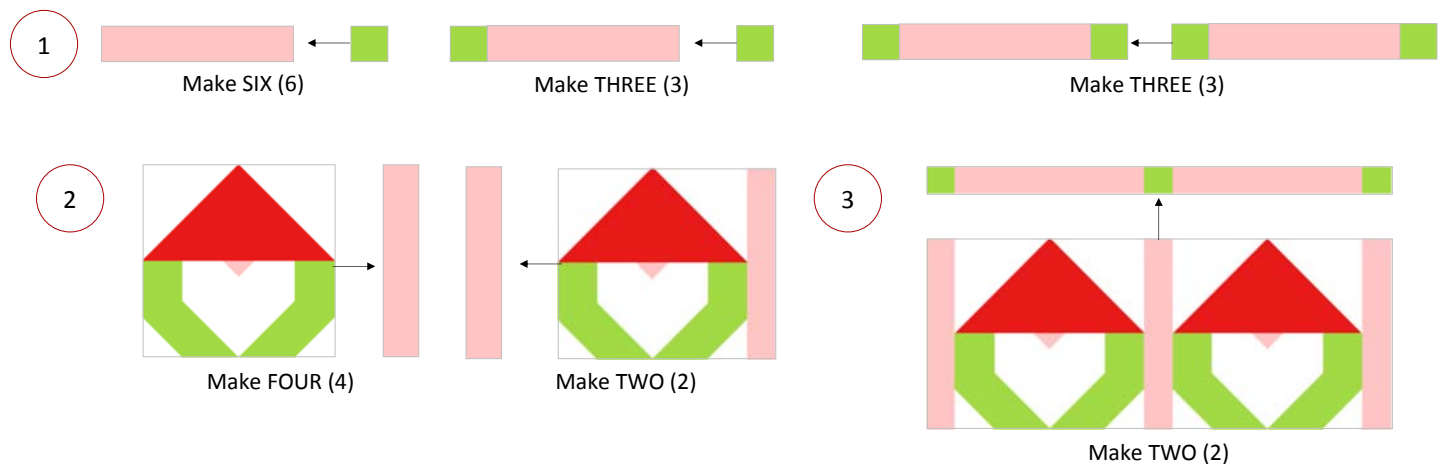
“Santa Gnome”
Quilt Block
Make FOUR (4)

Fabric Cuts for Finishing the “Santa Gnome” Table Topper

Green	Cut NINE (9) 2” squares. (Sashing Cornerstones)
Pink	Cut TWELVE (12) 2” x 10 1/2” strips. (Sashing & Sashing Border)
Red	Cut TWO (2) 2” x 25” strips. (Left & Right Border)
Red	Cut TWO (2) 2” x 27 1/2” strips. (Top & Bottom Border)
Green	Cut & piece THREE (3) 1/2” x WOF strips (Binding)

Finishing Instructions:

- 1) Sew the Cornerstones to applicable Sashing strips.
- 2) Sew the Sashing & then the Sashing + Cornerstones to the applicable “Santa Gnome” quilt blocks.
- 3) Sew the newly created “Santa Gnome” quilt blocks to create TWO (2) rows.
- 4) Sew the newly created TWO (2) rows to each other.
- 5) Sew the Left & Right Borders to the newly created “Santa Gnome” Table Topper.
- 6) Sew the Top & Bottom Borders to the newly created “Santa Gnome” Table Topper.
- 7) Quilt as desired & then sew on your binding!



This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.

Finishing Instructions:

- 1) Sew the Cornerstones to applicable Sashing strips.
- 2) Sew the Sashing & then the Sashing + Cornerstones to the applicable “Santa Gnome” quilt blocks.
- 3) Sew the newly created “Santa Gnome” quilt blocks to create TWO (2) rows.
- 4) Sew the newly created TWO (2) rows to each other.
- 5) Sew the Left & Right Borders to the newly created “Santa Gnome” Table Topper.
- 6) Sew the Top & Bottom Borders to the newly created “Santa Gnome” Table Topper.
- 7) Quilt as desired & then sew on your binding!



The More Gnomes the Merrier!

This pattern explains how to make ONE (1) single “Santa Gnome” quilt block & ONE (1) “Santa Gnome” Table Topper.

With this pattern it’s possible to make a “Santa Gnome” Table Runner, a Long Table Runner, a Lap Quilt or a Quilt. Just decrease or increase the number of “Santa Gnome” quilt blocks to reach the desired size of the finished project!

Congrats!

Now that the “Santa Gnome” Table Topper is sewn together, it’s time to quilt as desired & then sew on the binding!

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.
