

The "Christmas Bells Lap Quilt" is a traditionally pieced free quilt pattern! This quilt block is more for a sewer who's able to sew Square in the Squares & Flying Geese by chain stitching the blocks. Which makes it ideal for confident beginning sewers & wonderful for those who are more advanced!

Finished Lap Quilt = 45" x 53"

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 12" Square

Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 12 1/2" Square

All seams a scant 1/4"

Press in the direction of the arrows

Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning

Cutting Requirements for SIXTEEN (16) "Christmas Bells Quilt Blocks"			
Fabric Color	First Cut	Second Cut	
Pink	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3 3/8" squares.	N/A	
Lt. Green	Cut SIXTY-FOUR (64) 2 7/8" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.	
Lt. Green	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/4" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square.	
Green	Cut FORTY-EIGHT (48) 3 3/8" squares.	N/A	
White	Cut NINETY-SIX (96) 2 7/8" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.	
White	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/4" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square.



Fabric Cuts for Finishing the "Christmas Bells Lap Quilt"		
Pink	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips. (Left & Right Border #1)	
Pink	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips. (Top & Bottom Border #1)	
Lt. Green	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3" x 64 1/2" strips. (Left & Right Border #3)	
Lt. Green	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3" x 57 1/2" strips. (Top & Bottom Border #2)	
Red	Cut & piece FIVE & ONE-HALF (5 1/2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)	

Finishing Instructions:

- 1) Sew the newly created "Christmas Bells Quilt Blocks" together starting with the center quilt blocks.
- 2) Sew the newly created rows to each other starting with the TWO (2) center rows.







- 6) Sew the top & bottom Border #2 to the newly created "Christmas Bells Lap Quilt"
- 7) Quilt as desired & then sew on your Binding!



How many times do you walk by a bell ringer at & around Christmastime?

They're usually stationed outside of your grocery stores and/or your favorite big box store. That is what this quilt should remind you of! The bell ringer is in the center of this quilt block!

This pattern explains how to make ONE (1) "Christmas Bells Lap Quilt." It can be made smaller (for a table topper) or larger (for a bed quilt).

Just decrease or increase the number of "Window Pane Chain Quilt Blocks" to reach the desired size of the finished project!

Congrats!

Now that the "Christmas Bells Lap Quilt" is sewn together, it's time to quilt as desired & then sew on the binding!
