






"Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt"



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The "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt" is a traditionally pieced free pattern! There are no triangles in this quilt. Which makes it perfect for beginning sewers & great for those who are more advanced!

Finished Lap Quilt = 56" Square Finished Blocks for Quilt = 10" Square Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 10 1/2" Square

All seams a scant 1/4" Press in the direction of the arrows **Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning**

Fabric Requirements		
Yellow	1/4 yard	
Green	1 1/2 yards (Includes Sashing Cornerstones & Binding)	
Red	1 5/8 yard (Includes Border)	
White	2 1/2 yard (Includes Sashing & Border #1)	







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"Christmas Wreath Quilt Block" Make SIXTEEN (16)

Cutting Requirements for SIXTEEN (16) "Christmas Wreath Quilt Blocks"			
Fabric Color	First Cut	Second Cut	
Yellow	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 4 3/8" squares.	N/A	
Red	Cut THIRTY-TWO (32) 3 3/8" squares.	N/A	
Red	Cut SIXTY-FOUR (64) 2 5/8" x 4 3/8" rectangles.	N/A	
Green	Cut ONE-HUNDRED & TWENTY- EIGHT (128) 2 5/8" squares.	N/A	
Green	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 3/4" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. Will yield FOUR (4) triangles per square.	
White	Cut SIXTY-FOUR (64)) 3 3/8"" squares.	Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. Will yield TWO (2) triangles per square.	
White	Cut THIRTY-TWO (32) 3 3/8"" squares.	On the back side of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.	

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






"Christmas Wreath Quilt Block" Instructions Press in the directions of the arrows!




Make SIXTY-FOUR (64) Half-Square Triangles. The finished size should be 2 5/8" square.






Make SIXTY-FOUR (64) Flying Geese. The finished size should be 2 5/8" x 4 3/8" rectangles..







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Fabric Cuts for Finishing the "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt"		
Green	Cut NINE (9) 2 1/2" squares (Sashing Cornerstones)	
White	Cut FIFTEEN (15) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips. (Sashing)	
White	Cut & piece TWO (2) 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border #1)	
White	Cut & piece TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips. (Top & Bottom Border #1)	
Red	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips. (Left & Right Border #2)	
Red	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips. (Top & Bottom Border #2)	
Green	Cut & piece SIX (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)	

Finishing Instructions:

- 1) Sew the newly created "Christmas Wreath Quit Blocks" together with the vertical Sashing.
- 2) Sew the Sashing Cornerstones to the Horizontal Sashing.
- 3) Sew the newly created "Christmas Wreath Quilt Blocks + Sashing together starting with the center quilt blocks.
- 4) Sew the newly created rows to each other starting with the TWO (2) center rows.
- 5) Sew the Left & Right Borders #1 to the newly created "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt."
- 6) Sew the Top & Bottom Borders #1 to the newly created "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt."
- 7) Sew the Left & Right Borders #2 to the newly created "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt."
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- 9) Quilt as desired & then sew on your Binding!

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




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

If a Christmas Wreath is hanging on the front door of a house, that is supposed to signify that the occupants are friendly, to Christmas visitors! That's the inspiration for this lap quilt!

This pattern explains how to make ONE (1) "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt." It can be made smaller (for a table topper) or larger (for a bed quilt).

Just decrease or increase the number of "Window Chain Quilt Blocks" to reach the desired size of the finished project!

Congrats!

Now that the "Christmas Wreath Lap Quilt" is sewn together, it's time to quilt as desired & then sew on the binding!

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.

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
