

# Quilt Projects with Jelly Rolls from BOMquilts.com

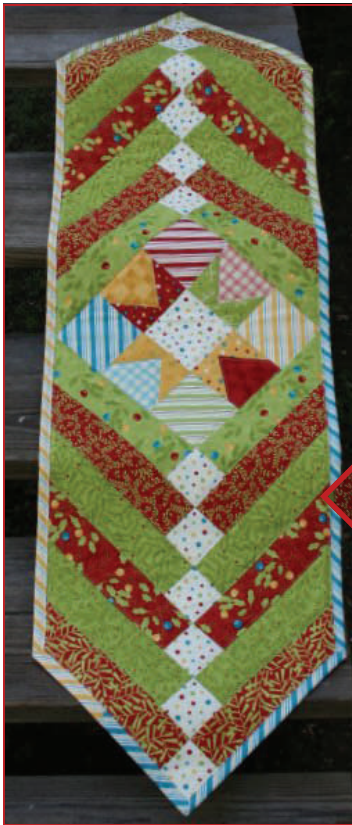
## Funtabulous Quick Table Runner

1/4" seam allowance

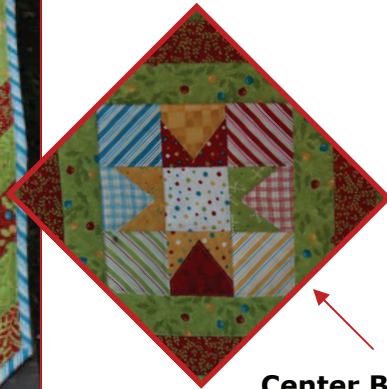
This project utilized fabrics from both a jelly roll and a charm pack from the "Holly Jolly" fabric line from Moda

BOMquilts.com **only** designed the center block for this table runner. We also changed the dimensions of the strips to 2 1/2" instead of the pattern's original 2" strips (making the strip length to be cut at 10 1/2"). 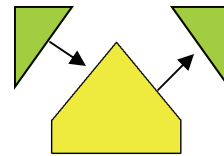


Fabric	Cut
4 Corner Squares	Cut ONE (1) *each color* 3 7/8" squares
Center Square	Cut ONE (1) 3 7/8" square
Four "Points" Colors	Cut ONE (1) *each color* template A pieces
Four "Points" Colors	Cut ONE (1) *each color* template C pieces
Four "Point Background" Colors	Cut ONE (1) *each color* template B pieces



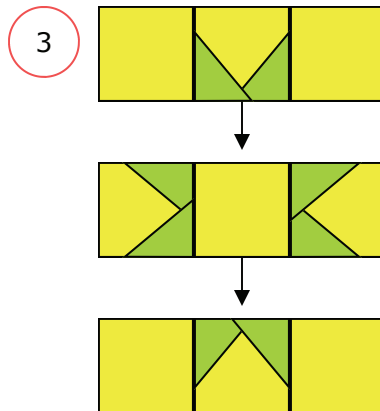
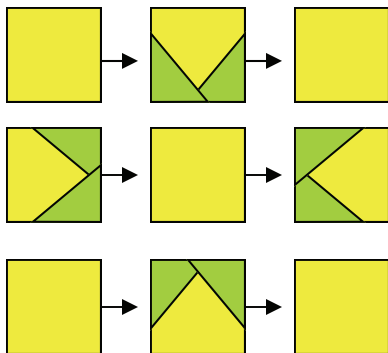
**Center Block Close-Up**

1 Sew the "Points" pieces together, as shown. Make FOUR (4).



**Little Note: The purpose of a nine-patch block of this design is that you'll have to work pretty hard to cut off your points!**

2 Now, put your nine-patch block together!



4 It's time to visit the QuiltBus.com link shown above to complete your table runner! Remember, use 2 1/2" squares and 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips instead of what you see on QuiltBus.com.
