Clue #4

Final Fabric Cuts

Fuchsia	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips (Left & Right Border)
Fuchsia	Cut & piece TWO (2) 3 1/2" x 78 1/2" strips (Top & Bottom Border)
Green	Cut & piece EIGHT (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)

Finished quilt = 78" square

Finished Blocks for Quilt = 24"

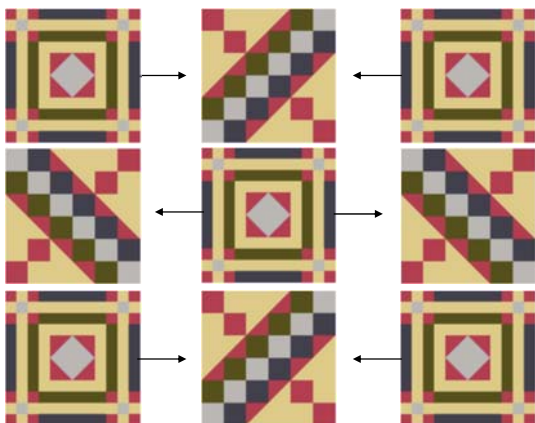
Unfinished Blocks for Quilt = 24 1/2"

All seams a scant 1/4".

Press in the direction of the arrows.

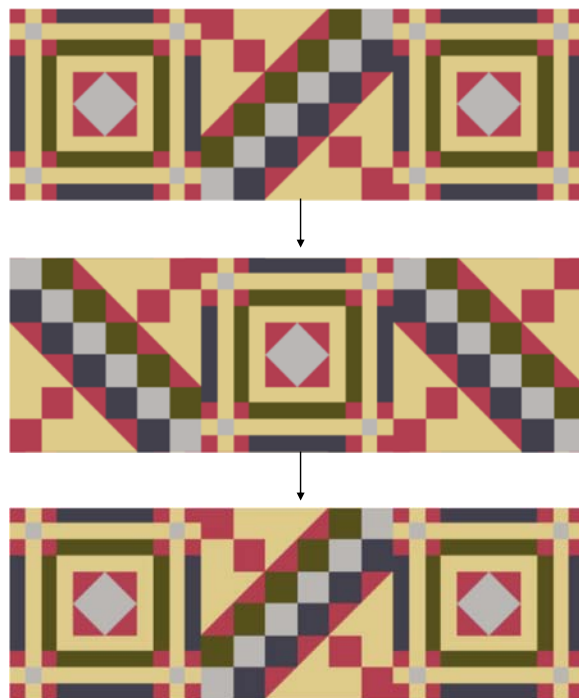
Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning

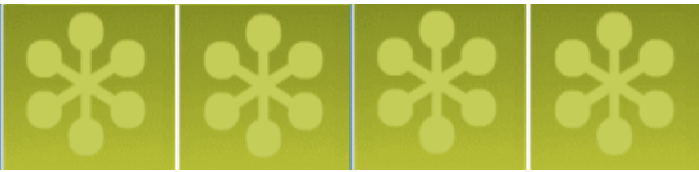

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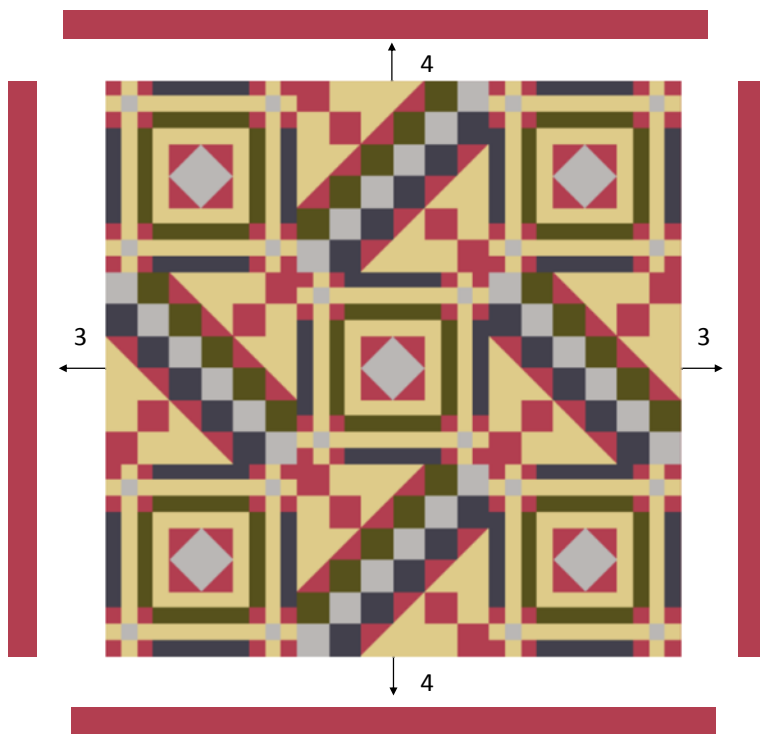
